Important Note:- Application shall be treated as incomplete and rejected, and application fees paid shall be forfeited if institution fails to submit print out of the applications made online, along with the land documents as required under sub-regulation (4) of Regulation 5 of NCTE Regulations, 2014, within 15 days of the submission of the online application to the concerned Regional Committee, in line with the provisions of section 7(2)(b) of NCTE Regulations, 2014. If any document is in Regional Language, the Institution is also required to upload and submit the notarized copy of English version of the document.
