



PUBLIC NOTICE

NCTE is mandated to achieve the planned and co-ordinated development of Teacher Education in the country. With the extension of the NCTE Act 1993 vide NCTE Gazette Notification dated 28.01.2020 and the MHRD, Government of India letter dated 01.10.2020 to UTs Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh, the NCTE proposes to invite online applications from remaining existing Teacher Education Institution (TEIs) located in the UTs of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh for recognition of existing Teacher Education Programmes/Courses for the academic year 2021-2022, which could not apply earlier between 30th July 2020 to 31st August 2021.

2. In pursuance of the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 06.11.2020, in Miscellaneous Application No.2024/2020 in Writ Petition Civil No276/2012 titled Maa Vaishno Devi Mahila Mahavidyalaya vs State of UP and others, the NCTE has decided to invite the aforesaid online applications between 11th Dec, 2020 to 07th Feb, 2021.
3. The Applicant institution/university must submit the duly filled online application to the Northern Regional committee, NCTE G-7, Sector-10 Dwarka, New Delhi-110075, along with the requisite documents and also with a formal recommendation of the concerned UT administration as mandated in NCTE Regulation, 2014.
4. 5(3) of Regulation-2014 states that: "The application shall be submitted online electronically along with the processing fee and scanned copy of required documents such as no objection certificate (NOC) issued by the concerned affiliating body. While submitting the application, it has to be ensured that the application is duly signed by the applicant on every page, including digital signature at appropriate place at the end of the application".
