**W.P.(C) 1082/2021 & CM APPL. 3022/2021 (stay)**

1. Issue notice. Mr. Tushar Gupta, learned counsel, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.
2. Counter affidavit be filed within four weeks. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within two weeks thereafter.
3. It is accepted by learned counsel for both sides that the impugned withdrawal order dated 27.06.2019, passed by the Eastern Regional Committee of the National Council of Teacher Education [“NCTE”], would take effect only from the end of the academic year 2020-2021 in terms of

Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993. Mr. Gupta states that he has specific instructions to this effect. It is therefore not necessary to pass any *ad-interim* orders in the petition.

4. In view of the aforesaid legal position, the respondents will update their website to reflect the status of the petitioner as a 'recognised institution' for the academic year 2020-2021. This will also be communicated to the Department of Higher Education, Government of Assam, and to the affiliating university of the petitioner.
