Ed course of one unit bearing application ID No. 10146 and submitted representation dated 30.07.2016 for one unit of D.El.Ed (Additional intake) and another representation dated 03.02.2018 mentioning D.El.Ed (Additional Course) which is contradictory.</p> <p>6. The first application that was filed by the institution for D.El.Ed course on 24.05.2015 and the date of grant of recognition was 26.03.2017.
