





Accordingly, NCTE is also revamping its various curricula of ITEP, 2 Year B.Ed. 1 Year B.Ed. and introducing new courses of 4 Year Physical Education and 4 Year Art Education in line with NEP 2020. These courses are also to be aligned to the various criteria laid down by UGC and in alignment with NHEQF, NCFSE and NCFTE.
