As per Clause 7(2)(b) of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the application shall be summarily rejected for failure to submit print out of the application made online along with the land documents as required under sub-regulation (4) of Regulation 5 within 15 days of the submission of the online application. In this case, no information in this regard has been received from the institution earlier. In light of Clause 7(1) of NCTE Regulations, 2014, in case of an application is not complete, or requisite document are not attached with the application, the application shall be treated as incomplete and rejected, and the application fees paid shall be forfeited.


4. A typed version of application for B.Ed. course bearing ID No.10056, Application No. ERCAPP201646003 (which was not earlier shown on the NCTE dashboard and not received by ERC NCTE) was found attached along with the copy of Court Order dated 24.01.2022 now placed for consideration of ERC NCTE. No document/record related to submission of application is there available at ERC, NCTE.

Accordingly, the institution is deficient on the following points in the light of NCTE Regulation 2014.

1. Affidavit on Rs. 100 stamp paper from the President / Secretary of the Management duly notarized giving the details of applications pending with NCTE and also the existing courses being run by the management on the same land where this application is proposed.
2. To submit the proof of submission of initial application to ERC in original, self-attested.
3. To submit the proof of rejection of initial application by ERC in original, duly self-attested if any.

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

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

The certified copy of transfer of land and building in the name of institution as per Clause 8 (4) (iii) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 not submitted after issuance of withdrawal order dated 01.02.2020. Further, in the registered transfer Absolute Sale Deed, there is no mention of constructed building on the basis of which the recognition was granted by ERC, NCTE. The copy of land document (Sale Deed) registered dated 31.03.2011 is in the name of (1) Shri Rajendra Rai and (2) Ram Baran Ray Educational Trust, whereas the copy of transfer of Absolute Sale Deed registered dated 20.04.2016 shows that only Shri Rajendra Rai sells the land/property in the name of institution viz.R.B.R. B.Ed. College and there is no mention of the name of trust i.e. Ram Baran Ray Educational Trust. Further, it is mentioned in Change of Land Use Certificate issued by AnumandalPadadhikari, Hajipur dated 17.09.2011 that the land will be used for educational purpose followed by point-5 of the affidavit dated 28.02.2012 related to land submitted by the institution, however, the use of land/property for education purpose is not mentioned in the transfer of Absolute Sale Deed submitted after withdrawal order dated 01.02.2020. In reference of point (i) to (iv), the institution has only submitted clarification in the form of notarized affidavit dated 26.02.2022

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
