Thereafter, in its 379th Meeting held on 17th January 2023, Committee decided that recognition be withdrawn on the ground of non-submission of any reply by the institutions in response to the final show cause notice.

On further search of records, it has been noticed that the following five institutions have already filled PAR for the academic session 2020-2021 to NCTE. However, their names were inadvertently included in the list of non-filling of PAR by institutions and accordingly considered and decided by WRC.

The Committee reviewed the matter and decided as under:

Non-encumbrance certificate dated 10.12.2019 not issued by competent Govt. Registering Authority. Khasra/Survey No. mentioned therein does not match with land documents, Building Plan and Building Completion Certificate. Building plan is not approved by competent Govt. Engineer. Same building plan submitted for another institution viz. Akshay Academy College. Building completion certificate (BCC) is not certified by competent Govt. Engineer. Name of teacher training programme and earmarked total built up area for each course is not reflected therein. Hence, it is not acceptable. The institution is recognized for B.Ed. and D.El.Ed. course. Failure to upload requisite documents on the portal shall be treated as a breach of the conditions of recognition under Clause 8(12) of NCTE Regulations, 2014. The institution seems to have submitted proposal for shifting of premises on land Survey No.423/2/3 having land area 6330.00 sq.mtr. which is likely to be on the same patch of land bearing Khasra No.423/2/2 having land area 6330 sq.mtr. in respect of another institution viz. Akshay Academy College, on the address of Village-Solsinda, Near Vishvnath Dham Mandir, Dist. Indore-452006, Madhya Pradesh. This needs to be clarified. From uploaded photos of institution building including classroom, laboratory, library,
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	 hall etc. where online inspection was conducted, it seems to be at same location and same address of another institution i.e. Akshay Academy College applied for shifting of premises. This needs to be clarified. Same Survey No.423/2 peiki mentioned in the Non-encumbrance certificate (issued by Advocate) as submitted by both the institutions i.e.
	 of both the institutions for the same location of land. This needs to be clarified. With regard to latitude and longitude as well as photos of building taken during conduct of online inspection in respect of both institutions i.e.Akshay Academy College and Cambridge International College, it is evident that proposal has been made for shifting of both institutions that appear to be at same building location, which is objectionable. This needs to be clarified.
	In view of the above, the Committee decided that a Show Cause Notice prior to the rejection of shifting application be issued to the institution u/s 17 of the NCTE Act. The institution shall submit a reply accompanied by an original affidavit within 30 days from the date of uploading of minutes on the website failing which the WRC will take a decision as deemed fit as per the provisions contained in the NCTE Act and Regulations.
