stayed applications against the orders passed by the Hon'ble Court(s) for processing of applications in view of the decision of the General Body.

2. The LPA in the following two cases of the category under Non- Chotu Ram cases may be preferred before the Division Bench of the Hon'ble Court of Delhi.
 - i) W.P. (C) No. 8993/2021 and Cont. Case No. 500/2022 titled TSK T. T. College v/s NCTE & Anr.
 - ii) W.P. (C) No. 3101/20220&Cont. Case No. 486/2022 titled Shree Shyam T.T. School & Anr. v/s NCTE & Anr.
- 3) The Contempt Cases falling under the category of Chotu Ram have been stayed in light of the order dated 08.08.2022 passed by the Supreme Court of India in SLP (C) No. 10793/2022. Therefore, these cases cannot be processed until further orders from the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
