The original file of the Institution along-with other related documents, directions of the Hon'ble Court were carefully considered and examined by WRC in the light of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the following observation were made: 1. The approval letter of the affiliating university not submitted. In view of the above, the Committee decided that show Cause Notice prior to refusal of recognition be issued to the institution u/s 14 (3) (b) of the NCTE Act for M.Ed. programme.
