The appellent institution is directed to forward to the WRC the documents submitted in the appeal within 15 days from the receipt of order of the appeal and after receipt of the same the WRC to take further necessary action as per the NCTE Regulation, 2014 guidelines and amendments issued from time to time in terms of directions given herein above"</i>
