



The Committee decided to issue show cause notice on (i) the details of faculty members is not as per BA.B.Ed. programme, (ii) website of the institution has not been developed & designed as per clause 7(14)(i) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014. The matter was considered in 299th meeting held on 01st to 05th April, 2019 and the Committee decided to grant recognition for BA.B.Ed. course for one unit from the academic session 2020-21.
