They were given FR for B.Ed (2 units).</p> <p>3. Thereafter, the Telaaranga Govt. has sent a complaint that names of 4 Faculty members, working in other private colleges have been shown fraudulently.</p> <p>4.1 The applicant institution has given a detailed reply. They have explained that the 4 Assistant Professors in reference are indeed employed elsewhere. But, they are interested in joining the applicant institution. They were duly interviewed and selected for appointment with the approval of the university. But, they will actually join the assignment only when the formal clearance are finally received for commencing the B.Ed programme. Otherwise, the institution will have to start paying them salary for no work.</p> <p>4.2 This reply sounds convincing. The SRC has no reason to suspect foul play. Institutions have to adopt this practice because the NCTE Regulations ask for ‘approved faculty list’ even at the LOI stage.</p> <p>4.3 That being so, the SRC accepts the reply from the institution.</p> <p>5.1 Let us give a final reply accordingly to the Telagana government and close this complaint case. The other complaint is about fire-safety measures not being provided.</p> <p>5.2 The institution have categorically stated that fire-safety measures have been taken. In the absence of any</p>

				<p>norms in the NCTE Regulations, they have requested the District Fire Safety officer to inspect and certify. The fee paid for the inspection is on record. The certificate issued is also on record.</p> <p>5.3 The SRC, therefore, accepts their reply on this point.</p> <p>6.1 The third complaint is about faculty members not having the prescribed 3 years experience.</p> <p>6.2 The institution has pointed out that there is no such provision in the Regulations. The SRC accepts this contention. In fact, in another context the SRC had separately sent a communication to the Telagana Government explaining the misconception about the 3-year experience clause. The relevant part of that communication is reproduced here for ready reference:</p> <p>(i) The State Govt. has complained that no Faculty member has 3 years experience as required in the NCTE Norms.</p> <p>(ii) It may be clarified that the NCTE Regulations prescribe experience requirement only for Principals. There is no such provision for Faculty Members.</p> <p>(iii) There is a provision relating to equivalence of degrees, especially relating to the Persp. Group. It says that B.Ed for 3 years teaching experience will be equivalent to M.Ed. Possibly, this has caused some confusion.</p>
