The earlier decision of the meeting is reproduced below:

"NRC decided that Show-cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which did not submit affidavit for compliance of NCTE Regulations, 2014 in respect of these courses. The Committee also decided that show-cause notice be issued to all such institution which did not submit compliance of the revised recognition orders"

This decision will be applicable for such institutions under the similar category and apprised the same accordingly with the direction to submit their reply within 30 days after the issue of the SCN.
