The accreditation once obtained shall be valid for a period of five years and the recognised and already accredited Teacher Education Institutions shall be required to get accreditation renewed by the agency identified for the purpose by the Council before the lapse of the earlier accreditation.
- iv. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
- v. The Norms for teaching staff in respect of their qualifications and experience shall be as per provisions of NCTE Regulations, 2014, as amended from time to time.
- 2. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, State Government etc. as applicable, and compliance of the following by the affiliating body, State Govt. and also the concerned recognised Institution:
 - i. The affiliating body/State Govt. shall be required to verify the authenticity of the land, building documents submitted by the institution, with the required land & built up area as well as appointment of requisite teaching, non-teaching staff as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 before grant of affiliation to the institution.
 - ii. The affiliating body shall ensure that the institution is a composite institution as per definition of a "composite institution" given in the NCTE Regulation, 2014. If at any

institution, the recognition
granted shall be treated as
withdrawn and the sole
responsibility of the same will
be of the institution. However,
