Appointment letters and joining report of approved faculty 3. As far as the requirement of composite is concerned, it should be noted that the institution has not submitted any proof to move towards composite which is a

				<p>mandatory requirement as per regulation 2(b) (Multidisciplinary as per NEP-2020 which is implemented by Govt. of India on 29th July 2020 and has become a part of regulation as per gazette notification 22nd October 2021). However, in the light of directions passed by Hon'ble High court in various orders, the committee has decided to NOT PRESS the requirement for composite structure subject to the statutory remedy of appeal/Review and judicial orders, if any.</p> <p>4. Court directed to process the application as per the decision of the GPS college, in which direction was given to follow 2009 regulations where NOC and the Composite was not required but besides NOC and composite, there is a difference in duration of the course (B.ed– one year to two year-) faculty requirement and the qualification of the faculty. So it is not feasible to process the application on the basis of 2009 regulations.</p> <p>5.
