

- 8. Needless to state, this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the claim of the petitioners, and therefore, in case the petitioners are aggrieved by any order passed by the respondents, it will be open for the petitioners to seek legal recourse as permissible in law.
- 9. With the aforesaid observations, the instant petition stands disposed of.
- The matter was considered by NRC in its 416<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup>December 2023, and the Committee decided to issue First Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of NCTE Act, 1993, before withdrawal of recognition.
- The Committee also found the proposal / application of shifting of premises of the institution deficient in terms of the following: -

- The aforesaid notification was challenged before the Hon'ble High Court of Rajasthan at Jodhpur Bench. The Hon'ble High Court of Rajasthan at Jodhpur passed an order dated 25.11.2021 and set aside the NCTE Notification dated 28.06.2018. The said judgment passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Rajasthan at Jodhpur was further challenged before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
- The Hon'ble Supreme Court vide its judgment dated 11/08/2023 in Devesh Sharma Vs UOI and ors. had upheld the Order dated 25.11.2021 passed by the High Court of Rajasthan at Jodhpur and quashed & set aside the NCTE Notification dated 28/06/2018 whereby the applicants having B.Ed. degree are no longer eligible for consideration of appointment as a school teacher for classes I to V.
