- The Ministry of Education *inter-alia* directed NCTE to invite applications from the UT of J&K and UT of Ladakh from 01.07.2020 to 31.08.2020 and the TEIs functioning in J&K/Ladakh may be allowed to continue as such for the academic session 2020-21.
- NCTE issued Public Notice inviting applications from the UT of J&K & UT of Ladakh between 30,07,2020 to 31,08,2020,
- Central University of Jammu had applied on 31.08.2020 for 4-Year Integrated programme leading to B.A. B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. degree,
- The Ministry of Education vide letter dated 01.10.2020 directed NCTE to extend the timeline for inviting applications from the UTs of J&K and Ladakh till 20.11.2020.
- NCTE issued another Public Notice dated 07.12.2020 inviting applications from the UTs of J&K & Ladakh between 11.12.2020 to 07.02.2021.
- The Ministry of Education vide letter dated 02.09.2021 granted relaxation under Section 29 of the NCTE Act 1993 to the institutions located in the UTs of J&K and Ladakh until December 2022,
- The Norms and Standards for B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. were omitted from the NCTE Regulations, 2014 vide NCTE Notification dated 26.10.2021.
- MoE vide letter dated 15.09.2023 conveyed the approval of the Competent authority u/s 29 of the NCTE Act, 1993 on the proposal of NCTE subject to following conditions:-
 - (i) All the institutions will have to submit compliance to the deficiencies pointed out by NRC on or before 30^{th} October 2023, so as to enable NRC to take final decision on the application of the institution / university.
 - (ii) No admission can be made for the academic session 2024-25 without formal recognition from NRC-NCTE.
- The relaxation will be applicable to all the 140 institutions, as per the list at Annexure of the above-mentioned letter of the NCTE for the course(s) as mentioned against each institution.
- It is further on record that the Central University of Jammu had applied for transition of its courses from B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. to ITEP vide application No. 2526202403042070 and 2526202402191447 for B.Sc.B.Ed. and B.A.B.Ed. respectively in the month of March 2024.
- MoE vide letter No. 21-2/2021-IS.1 dated 22.07.2024 conveyed the approval of the competent authority in the Department as under:

"In order to safeguard the interest of students, the competent authority in the Department has acceded to the proposal of NCTE for granting relaxation to the Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) located in the UTs of J&K and Ladakh from complying with norms and standards of NCTE upto 31st December 2024. The UT administration may take all necessary steps to ensure compliance of NCTE's norms in future."

The Committee further noted that the name of the Central University of Jammu is not included in the list of 140 institutions sent by NRC to NCTE (HQ). The list of institutions were sent in respect to those institutions only which were offering teacher education programs other than B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. programme as this programme was omitted vide NCTE notification dated 26.10.2021. However, on perusal of the continuous extension by the Ministry, it transpires that the programme(s) being offered by the institutions of UTs of J&K and Ladakh are valid till the session 2024-2025 despite the fact that

B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed programme were omitted and in deed this is on account of the circumstantial status of UTs of J&K and Ladakh. Needless to mention that the institutions duly recognized by NCTE can only offer the teacher education programme from session 2025-2026.

In view of the above circumstances and considering the peculiar situation of UT of J& K and UT of Ladakh, the NRC had decided in its meeting to issue LoI to the Central University of Jammu for B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course and accordingly, LoI was issued on 14.02.2023.

As regards the eligibility to apply for transition into ITEP is concerned, it is mentioned that the institution which are offering the B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. programme are only eligible for the transition into ITEP. In the instant case, the Central University of Jammu is offering this course and thus eligible for transition. Other aspect is that this course has not been recognized by the NCTE in the University, however, still valid in terms of the extension of time line given by the Ministry under which the institutions are required to meet the norms and standard defined by the NCTE amended from time to time.

Accordingly, the Committee unanimously concluded the following:

- The course B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. run by the Central University of Jammu has a valid recognition as on date by virtue of the MoE letter dated letter No. 21-2/2021-IS.1 dated 22.07.2024 although it has not been granted formal recognition by NCTE due to omission of N&S for the said course and even also it was not included in the list of 140 institutions.
- The application of the J&K for grant of recognition of B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course for which LOI
 was issued by NRC, may not be processed further rather the University be allowed to transit into
 ITEP.
- Inspection of the University has already been conducted on its application for grant of recognition for B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course. Thus, there is no further need for inspection of this Government Institution.

In view of the above and the reply of the institution and the Committee decided the following:

The institutions which were offering the Teacher Education courses in the UT of Jammu & Kahmir and Ladakh prior to enactment of the Jammu & Kashmir Reorganization Act, 2019 (34 of 2019) on 09.08.20219 and subsequent inclusion of the UTs of J&K and Ladakh needs special consideration on the following grounds:

- The Ministry of Education inter-alia directed NCTE to invite applications from the UT of J&K and UT of Ladakh from 01.07.2020 to 31.08.2020 and the TEIs functioning in J&K/Ladakh may be allowed to continue as such for the academic session 2020-21.
- NCTE issued Public Notice inviting applications from the UT of J&K & UT of Ladakh between 30.07.2020 to 31.08.2020.
- Central University of Jammu had applied on 31.08.2020 for 4-Year Integrated programme leading to B.A. B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. degree.
- The Ministry of Education vide letter dated 01.10.2020 directed NCTE to extend the timeline for inviting applications from the UTs of J&K and Ladakh till 20.11.2020.
- NCTE issued another Public Notice dated 07.12.2020 inviting applications from the UTs of J&K & Ladakh between 11.12.2020 to 07.02.2021.
- The Ministry of Education vide letter dated 02.09.2021 granted relaxation under Section 29 of the NCTE Act 1993 to the institutions located in the UTs of J&K and Ladakh until December 2022.
- The Norms and Standards for B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. were omitted from the NCTE Regulations, 2014 vide NCTE Notification dated 26.10.2021.
- MoE vide letter dated 15.09.2023 conveyed the approval of the Competent authority u/s 29 of the NCTE Act, 1993 on the proposal of NCTE subject to following conditions:-
 - (i) All the institutions will have to submit compliance to the deficiencies pointed out by NRC on or before 30th October 2023, so as to enable NRC to take final decision on the application of the institution / university.
 - (ii) No admission can be made for the academic session 2024-25 without formal recognition from NRC-NCTE.
- The relaxation will be applicable to all the 140 institutions, as per the list at Annexure of the above-mentioned letter of the NCTE for the course(s) as mentioned against each institution.
- It is further on record that the Central University of Jammu had applied for transition of its courses from B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. to ITEP vide application No. 2526202403042070 and 2526202402191447 for B.Sc.B.Ed. and B.A.B.Ed. respectively in the month of March 2024.
- MoE vide letter No. 21-2/2021-IS.1 dated 22.07.2024 conveyed the approval of the competent authority in the Department as under:

"In order to safeguard the interest of students, the competent authority in the Department has acceded to the proposal of NCTE for granting relaxation to the Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) located in the UTs of J&K and Ladakh from complying with norms and standards of NCTE upto 31st December 2024. The UT administration may take

all necessary steps to ensure compliance of NCTE's norms in future."

The Committee further noted that the name of the Central University of Jammu is not included in the list of 140 institutions sent by NRC to NCTE (HQ). The list of institutions were sent in respect to those institutions only which were offering teacher education programs other than B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. programme as this programme was omitted vide NCTE notification dated 26.10.2021. However, on perusal of the continuous extension by the Ministry, it transpires that the programme(s) being offered by the institutions of UTs of J&K and Ladakh are valid till the session 2024-2025 despite the fact that B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed programme were omitted and in deed this is on account of the circumstantial status of UTs of J&K and Ladakh. Needless to mention that the institutions duly recognized by NCTE can only offer the teacher education programme from session 2025-2026.

In view of the above circumstances and considering the peculiar situation of UT of J& K and UT of Ladakh, the NRC had decided in its meeting to issue LoI to the Central University of Jammu for B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course and accordingly, LoI was issued on 14.02.2023.

As regards the eligibility to apply for transition into ITEP is concerned, it is mentioned that the institution which are offering the B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. programme are only eligible for the transition into ITEP. In the instant case, the Central University of Jammu is offering this course and thus eligible for transition. Other aspect is that this course has not been recognized by the NCTE in the University, however, still valid in terms of the extension of time line given by the Ministry under which the institutions are required to meet the norms and standard defined by the NCTE amended from time to time.

Accordingly, the Committee unanimously concluded the following:

- The course B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. run by the Central University of Jammu has a valid recognition
 as on date by virtue of the MoE letter dated letter No. 21-2/2021-IS.1 dated 22.07.2024 although
 it has not been granted formal recognition by NCTE due to omission of N&S for the said course
 and even also it was not included in the list of 140 institutions.
- The application of the J&K for grant of recognition of B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course for which LOI
 was issued by NRC, may not be processed further rather the University be allowed to transit into
 ITEP.
- Inspection of the University has already been conducted on its application for grant of recognition for B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course. Thus, there is no further need for inspection of this Government Institution.

In view of the above and the reply of the institution and the Committee decided the following:

- Letter of Intent (LoI) under clause 7(13) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 prior to grant
 of formal recognition and compliance of the following provisions as envisaged in
 NCTE Regulations, 2014 as well as guidelines issued by the NCTE Hqrs. thereof, may
 be issued.
 - The institution shall submit the list of faculties having required qualification as per NCTE Regulations 2014 as amended from time to time duly approved by the concerned affiliating body.

- The institution is required to clarify as to how it obtained affiliation from the Guru Govind Singh Indraprastha University, Delhi with different name & style.
- The institution is required to submit session-wise affiliation letter issued by the affiliating body for conducting B.Ed. course from the year 2015 onwards.
- The institution is also required to submit the session-wise list of students admitted in B.Ed. course from the year 2015 onwards certified by Registrar, Guru Govind Singh Indraprastha University, Delhi.

Hence, the Committee decided that First Show Cause Notice be issued to the institution to submit reply on the deficiencies mentioned above within 21 days from the date of issue of First Show Cause Notice.

The Committee also decided that to send a letter to the Registrar, Guru Govind Singh
