



The mutation/ Zamabandhi is submitted.2. The latest faculty list not submitted by the institution.3. Appointment letter issued to the faculty members and joining affidavit not submitted.4. Last six month salary statement of the faculty members not submitted.5. As far as the requirement of composite is concerned, it should be noted that the institution has not submitted any proof to move towards composite which is a mandatory requirement as per regulation 2(b) (Multidisciplinary as per NEP-2020 which is implemented by Govt. of India on 29th July 2020 and has become a part of regulation as per gazette notification 22nd October 2021). However, in the light of directions passed by Hon'ble High court in various orders, the committee has decided to NOT PRESS the requirement for composite structure subject to the statutory remedy of appeal/Review and judicial orders, if any. <p>The said order was withdrawn earlier only for the session 2021-2022 as per the direction of the Hon'ble High Court, Delhi W.P. 



Further, the institution has submitted a copy of land documents which is registered on 24.11.2021 in the name of Baba Shirdi Nath College (Gift Deed) which is registered after the date of online application and the same is not acceptable as per rules.2. Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Authority indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances not submitted.3. Photocopy of Building Completing Certificate submitted by the institution is not in the prescribed format. <p>Hence, the Committee decided that the recognition be refused to the institution u/s 14/15 (3)(b) of the NCTE Act, 1993.</p>
