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

It was brought to the notice of the committee that 2008 colleges have furnished the information which was sought by the NRC vide its public notice dated 02.01.2020. The committee appreciated the number i.e. 2008 and decided that another public notice be issued and all the colleges falling under the jurisdiction of NRC may be directed to furnish the information as sought in the previous one.

Further, the gazette notification no. CD-DL-E-29012020-215777 issued by NCTE in file no. NCTE-CDN012/3/2019-US(CDN)-HQ(E) dated 27.01.2020 (published on 29.01.2020) was placed before the committee. The state of Rajasthan has been shifted to the jurisdiction of Western Regional Committee, NCTE (henceforth WRC) and all the files are now required to be handed over to WRC without delay. The committee decided that all the current/running files may be handed over to WRC on or before 17.02.2020. The list of files handed over to WRC may be placed in the next meeting of NRC. The list must indicate the status of each and every file. The committee also decided that the ITEP applications received from Rajasthan be transferred to WRC online. The Committee unanimously decided that the action(s) on the decisions taken upto 311th Meeting (and the corrigendum) by NRC should be done by RD, NRC and then such files be immediately sent to WRC.




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Thereafter, the issue of recognition of TEIs in J & K and Ladakh was discussed and it was agreed unanimously that the NRC may wait for the instructions from the NCTE, HQ in this regard. In the meanwhile, RD may write to the concerned authorities for nominations of members (as state representative) in NRC.

The committee was informed about the large number of ITEP applications received from the state of Uttar Pradesh and the court cases filed by the aggrieved colleges. The committee after due deliberations decided that all such applications may be processed on merits and a list of all such cases may be placed before NRC in upcoming meetings. This decision should be informed to the NCTE, HQ so as to avoid further complexities.

The issue of 10 colleges of Rajasthan wherein the matter is pending with NCTE, HQ was discussed. The committee decided that detailed report in respect of letter number 1-2/2019/NCTE/MS Office/86297 dated 19.12.2019 be called and placed before the NRC. The committee decided to call for the following information/documents/details –

- i. Annexures as mentioned at Flag-A in the letter.
- ii. Copy of order of constitution of committee
- iii. Copy of Terms of Reference of the committee
- iv. The copy of documents received/obtained from the state government of Rajasthan.
