- As per decision of NRC in its 311<sup>th</sup> meeting the recognition for B.Ed. course was withdrawn to the institution vide order dated 09/07/2020.
- The institution filed an appeal to NCTE (HQ) under section 18 of NCTE Act, 1993 against withdrawal order dated 09/07/2020. The appellate authority passed an order dated 16/11/2022 and decided that the instant appeal deserves to be rejected and therefore, the impugned withdrawal order dated 09/07/2020 issued by NRC is confirmed.

However, the institution did not participate in the meeting.

Accordingly, an email was sent to the institution on 28/01/2025. The representative of the institution did not appear for hearing before NRC.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the present case and with the consent of the parties, this Court disposes off the writ petition permitting the petitioner to submit a fresh representation before the newly impleaded respondent no-5-Regional Director (Northern Region) NCTE New Delhi for correcting the name of the College uploaded on the website of NCTE within a period of four weeks from today. The respondent no.4 is also directed to approach the respondent no. 5-Regional Director (Northern Region) NCTE New Delhi for correcting the name of the College on the website of NCTE within a period of one month from day.
- 11. The newly impleaded respondent no.5 is directed to verify the aforesaid fact from the college and decide the representation of the petitioner within a period of two months thereafter.

Further, in this plot of land, a residential structure of 250 sq. mtrs has also been constructed for residential purpose. - The institution has not submitted compliance regarding revised recognition order till date.
- The NRC office received another complaint received from the In-charge (Colleges) Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak vide its letter dated Endst. No. CB-IX/2015/11157-58 dated 20.03.2015. Based upon its enquiry report, the University has requested that the approval of the NCTE for B.Ed. programme be withdrawn of the institutions which are much lacking in infrastructure, teaching faculty and not holding classes regularly. The NCTE is informed for taking action against these institutions. But NCTE does not seem to be serious on such issues which have much importance for the benefit of the students. The institutions are required to hold classes to have a minimum of 200 teaching days as per NCTE and 75% attendance as per university rules for appearing in an examination for which the approval / affiliation is granted by NCTE/University. The institutions which are not holding regular classes have no right for further affiliation for approval. For implementing strictly, the University issued instructions vide letter No. CN-IX/2015/4598-4898 dated 21.01.2015. Since NCTE is regulating body, it is for the NCTE to take immediate action on receipt of recommendations from the University on those institutions which are much to be desired in infrastructure, teaching faculty and non-serious of holding classes. The University having important role in higher education cannot be a silent spectator. Therefore, the University conducted inspections/ surprise checking in the case of the following institutions which are lacking in providing the facilities required to the students:
  - i. A.S. Kharab Memorial College of Education, VPO- Kansi, Distt. Jhajjar (HR-515)
  - ii. Sree Shiv Chaitnya College of Education, Bohra Kalan, Distt. Gurgaon (HR-517)
- iii. Lt. Mahipat Singh College of Education, Chhara-Beri Road, Bahadurgarh, Distt. Jhajjar (HR-928)
- iv. Shanti College of Education, Village Rewasa, Distt. Mohindergarh (HR-1645)
- v. Yaduvanshi College of Education, VPO Patikra, Tehsil Narnaul, Distt. Mohindergarh (HR-475)
- vi. Shri Ram College of Education, Diwan Colony, Near DSP Office, Mohindergarh (HR-467).
- ❖ It is further stated by the University that the reports submitted by the inspection committee/ surprise visit committees are self explanatory and functioning of the institutions are much to be desired. So, the institutions which are playing with the career of the student cannot be allowed to function more. The University administration has considered the reports and after due consideration, it is recommended that approval of such institutions be withdrawn by the NCTE. We will appreciate if action on the part of NCTE is taken in a time-bound manner and preferably within a month. If no reply is received from NCTE within the stipulated periods, the University would be compelled to di-affiliate the institutions after

  - As per NCTE guidelines, the said college also does not have the Building Completion Certificate.
  - As per NCTE guidelines, the college must have a proper road to enter but there is no such road, as this college is situated in the middle of the village where there is only 5 feet passage to move.
  - As per NCTE guidelines, the college must have Fire NOC but that too is not available.
  - As per NCTE, CLU certificate is necessary, but they had submitted fake certificate which bears fake stamp.
  - As per NCTE guidelines, MAP of college is also not approved by municipal cooperation.
  - As per NCTE, no other activity can be done in college premises, but contrary to this, there is Buffalo tabela in college where they do milk farming business.
  - As per NCTE, no Society member can become principal, but in this college from last 10 to 15 years, one person (member of society) illegally has hold the post of Principal and that is also ignoring age criteria of 60 years.
