		<p>3. The Appellate Authority vide its order dated 31/10/2023 set-aside the withdrawal order dated 26/7/2023 and remanded back the case to NRC.</p> <p>4. In compliance of appeal order, the institution has submitted documents in the office of NRC vide its letter dated 24/11/2023.</p> <p>5. The institution has also filed W.P. No. 11698/2024 & CM Appl. No. 48636/2024 before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and Hon'ble High Court has passed order dated 30.08.2024 in the said petition . The operative part of the order is as under: -</p> <p>“2 This court is constrained to pass this order since the respondent no.2 i.e. Northern Regional committee ('NRC') has failed to decided the order of restoration of recognition of the petitioner though the documents were tendered by the petitioner on 24-11-2023. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the counselling will conclude on 20-9-2024.</p> <p>3. In view thereof, the respondent no.2 is directed to decide the NRC of the petitioner within seven days positively under intimation to the petitioner.</p> <p>4. This order has been passed in the presence of learned counsel for respondent no.2 and, therefore, if there is any delay in according the order, the petitioner will be at liberty to approach this Court in accordance with law.</p> <p>5. In view of the above, the present petition along with pending application(s), if any, stands disposed of.</p> <p>6. The order be uploaded on the website forthwith”</p> <p>In compliance of above referred order of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and order passed by the Appellate Authority, the case was considered by NRC and the following decision were taken: -</p> <p>i) The recognition of the two-year B.Ed. In compliance of order dated 20/08/2024 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in the W.P. (C) 8713/2024 & CM Appl 35576/2024 and order dated 3/9/2024 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in the Cont. case (C) No. 1391/2024, the case of this institution was considered by NRC and NRC decided as follow: -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • As per the provision of clause 8 (7) of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the land should be on ownership basis and Govt. land can be on lease basis. Therefore, the Land on which the institution has been shifted without prior approval of NRC taken on private lease basis cannot be considered for conducting inspection. • The recognition has already been withdrawn on this ground. Therefore, in this case amended review petition taking above and all other grounds be filled immediately. • In case the relief is not granted by the Hon'ble High Court in the review petition, the LPA be filed with the stay application against the order dated 20/08/2024 passed by the Hon'ble High Court. • The Standing Counsel of NRC be apprised of all above facts to defend the interest of NCTE.
