The institution preferred an appeal and the Appellate Authority vide order dated 19.08.2021 has remanded back the case to NRC. The NRC in its 348th meeting held on 12-13.10.2021 has decided to write a letter to the institution to submit certain documents within 15 days. As per the decision of NRC in its 365th (Vol-II) held on 08th and 09th March 2022, the withdrawal order was issued to the institution vide dated 08th April 2022. As per the decision of NRC in 374th meeting held on 24th Aug 2022, the institution was permitted to admit students for the session 2021-2022 and the withdrawal was effective from the academic session 2022-2023. The institution again preferred a Writ Petition and the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide order in W.P. No. 8779/2022 dated 11.10.2022 has quashed the Withdrawal order dated 08th April 2022. The institution again preferred a Writ Petition vide No. 1611/2023 and CM Appl 6123/2023 in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, praying the following :- <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Issue an appropriate writ, order or direction and hold that the Petitioner is a duly recognized institution for B.Ed. Issue a writ of mandamus and direct the Respondent no.2 to pass fresh order for restoration of recognition of the petitioner indicating that the petitioner duly recognized institution for B.Ed. Course for academic session 2023-24 and for all subsequent academic session;</p> <p>c. The institution is required to submit building plan approved by Govt. engineer mentioned total land area Khasra no./plot No., total built-up area and earmarked area for each come being run in the premises. 3. The institution is required to submit Land Use Certificate issued by Govt. competent Authority for Educational Purpose. 4. The institution is required to submit Non- Encumbrance Certificate issued by Govt. Competent Authority indicating that the Land is free from all encumbrance. 5. The institution is required to submit site plan with demarcated land area for running different course. 6. 


