The NRC made the following observations :-

The Hon'ble High Court of Punjab and Haryana in CWP No. 17369 of 2023 passed an Order dated 03.10.2023 and directed to constitute the necessary committee for inspection of colleges and take up the issue relating to grant of recognition in the states of Punjab and Haryana on urgent basis. The Hon'ble Court further directed us to submit a detailed report in this regard before it.

In compliance of the above directions of the Hon'ble Court, the NCTE conducted an inspection of the institution u/s 13 of NCTE Act, 1993 and considered the report in this meeting.

In view of the above, the NRC observed the following deficiencies as per the Visiting Team Report :-

1. The institution failed in submission of building safety certificate as per National / State Disaster Management Authority.
2. The building of the institution does not have lift and accessible toilet facilities for differently abled persons.
3. The institution failed to submit building completion certificate issued by the competent authority.
4. The multipurpose hall of the institution is not well furnished with permanent sound system.
5. The library facility is not upto prescribed norms and the seating capacity of reading room is very poor. The college must possess 4600 books and 2600 titles but against this, the college possess only 120 titles.
6. The college did not mention about the MoU signed with the practicing schools.
7. The college has only sitting capacity for 20% students against the required sitting capacity for 50% students.
8. As per the VT Report the Principal and other faculty is not qualified. Therefore, the institution is required to submit latest/current faculty list approved & signed each page by concerned affiliating body in original with the details of their teaching subject, date of birth, date of selection, date of joining, academic qualifications, teaching experience, NET/ Ph.D. (NCTE's GOI dated 09.06.2017), salary structure and related documents duly attested by authorized management representative not submitted. And, notarized original affidavit of Rs. 100/- on non-judicial stamp paper by the management and Rs. 10/- non-judicial stamp paper by each selected/ appointed faculty in the NCTE prescribed proforma.
9. The institution is required to submit details of salary disbursed to the faculty along with six months Bank statement and account number of each faculty members.

  4. Drawings are not clearly visible and readable. Drawings are in feet and inch are not acceptable. Room numbers and names should match.
1. During inspection, the institution only displayed the front and rear views of the building and failed to showcase other facilities such as laboratories, classrooms, the multipurpose hall, the canteen, the playground, principal's office etc.

6. The institution failed in submission of Building Safety Certificate issued by the competent authority.
7. The institution is required to submit latest/current faculty list approved & signed each page by concerned affiliating body in original with the details of their teaching subject, date of birth, date of selection, date of joining, academic qualifications, teaching experience, NET/ Ph.D. (NCTE's GOI dated 09.06.2017), salary structure and related documents duly attested by authorized management representative not submitted. And, notarized original affidavit of Rs. 100/- on non-judicial stamp paper by the management and Rs. 10/- non-judicial stamp paper by each selected/ appointed faculty in the NCTE prescribed proforma.
8. The institution is required to submit details of salary disbursed to the faculty along with six months Bank statement and account number of each faculty member.
9. The website of the institution is not updated as required under clause 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
10. The institution is required to submit a copy of the affiliation order issued by the concerned affiliating body for each course being run by the institution / society.
11. The FDRs towards Endowment and Reserve Funds are matured. The institution is required to get it revalidated submit to NRC with form 'A' duly signed by the concerned bank.
12. The institution did not appoint and failed in submission of details of the Administrative and Professional Staff to be appointed as required under clause 5.3 of Appendix 4 of NCTE Regulations, 2014.

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

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
