The college must possess 4600 books and 2600 titles but against this, the college possess only 120 titles. The college did not mention about the MoU signed with the practicing schools. The college has only siting capacity for 20% students against the required sitting capacity for 50% students. As per the VT Report the Principal and other faculty is not qualified. During inspection, the institution only displayed the front and rear views of the building and failed to showcase other facilities such as laboratories, classrooms, the multipurpose hall, the canteen, the playground, principal's office etc.


