In view of the above, the SRC decided that re-inspection of the institution be conducted for proposed Transition into ITEP.

- The institution may apply to NCTE afresh as and when the NCTE invites applications for Teacher Education Programme (s) through online portal.

The representation submitted by the institution was considered by SRC in its 442nd meeting held on 05th September 2024 and the SRC decided to issue Show Cause Notice to the institution on certain grounds. Accordingly, the SCN dated 11.09.2024 was issued to the institution.

The reply dated 11.09.2024 submitted by the institution was considered by SRC in its 454th meeting wherein SRC after thorough and detailed deliberation decided as under:-

 The SRC considered the entire matter and decided that as the recognition of the institution has already been withdrawn by SRC vide

order dated 01.10.2019, the SRC decided that the case is devoid of merits and the earlier withdrawal order issued to the institution (s) stands and no further action is required to be taken by SRC in this regard.

- The institution may apply to NCTE afresh as and when the NCTE invites applications for Teacher Education Programme (s) through online portal.

The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time were considered by SRC and SRC observed the following:-

- 1. The institution is recognized vide order F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed/2006-2007/15695 for B.Ed course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students
- 2. After promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the Revised order for two units of B.Ed Course of two years duration was issued to the institution vide dated 18.05.2015.
- 3. The recognition of the institution was withdrawn by SRC vide order No. F.SRO/NCTE/APSO7238/B.Ed/KA/393rd/2021/123114-3120 dated 19.01.2021, as per the decision of SRC in its 393rd meeting held on 05th-06th January 2021.
- 4. The institution preferred an appeal and the Appellate Authority vide order dated 30.06.2021 has confirmed the order of SRC.
- 5. The institution filed WP. No. 202002 of 2023 before the High Court of Karnataka and vide order dated 13.08.2023 the Hon'ble High Court has directed the followings:-
 - "4. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of in terms of the order made in aforementioned writ petition. The impugned orders dated 30.06.2021, in Appeal No.APPLSRC202113976 passed by respondent No.1 and withdrawal order dated 19.01.2021 passed by respondent No.2 in F.SRO/NCTE/APS07238/B.Ed./KA/393RD/2021/123114 are set aside.
 - 5. Liberty is reserved to the petitioner to give appropriate representation to respondent No.2 and thereafter, respondent No.2 having taken note of the same, shall take appropriate decision in the matter in accordance with law and inspect the premises of the petitioner Institution and pass appropriate orders accordingly."
 - 6. The matter was considered by SRC in its 429th meeting held on 11th October, 2023 wherein the SRC decided to issue Show Cause Notice to the institution on certain grounds. Accordingly, Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 20.10.2023.

The reply of the institution dated 26.08.2024 was considered by SRC in its 454th

meeting, wherein the SRC noted the following deficiencies:-

- In lieu of Land documents, the institution has submitted the Sale agreement executed on 18.1.2021 which is not acceptable.
- As per records of SRC, the institution has been granted recognition in 2007, Revised recognition order was issued in 2015 and the land documents submitted are registered in 2021. The institution has shifted to the new premises without the approval/permission from SRC.
- Converted / Diverted area is not mentioned in the Change of Land Use Certificate submitted by the institution.
- NEC submitted by the institution is dated 18.01.2021 for Sy.No.721.
 Latest NEC issued by the competent authority is not submitted by the institution.
- The joint FDRs submitted by the institution towards Endowment and Reserve Fund have already been matured.
- The institution has maintained the Reserve Fund of Rs. 3.00 lacs instead of 7.00 lacs required as per Regulations.
- The institution has not mentioned domain name of the website.
- Site plan is not submitted by the institution.

Therefore, the SRC decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 to submit reply / representation on the above grounds within 15 days from the date of issue of Final Show Cause Notice.

- 1. The application of the institution was rejected by SRC as per the decision of SRC in its 246th meeting of SRC held on 02nd to 04th June, 2013 on certain grounds.
- 2. The institution approached the Hon'ble High Court of Madurai Bench of Madras in W.P. (MD) No.5093/2022 and the directions of the Hon'ble Court were considered by SRC in its 431st meeting held on 10.01.2024 and the SRC decided that the application of the institution was rejected on 18.07.2013. Thus the file cannot be process for M.Ed. programme submitted by the institution on 27.12.2012 in the light of decision of 59th General Body Meeting of NCTE held on 04th December, 2023."
- 3. Accordingly, a letter dated 15.02.2024 was issued by the RD, SRC

informing the decision of 431st meeting.

- 4. Aggrieved from the above decision, the institution had filed a Writ Petition No. 6103 of 2024 in the Hon'ble High Court of Madras, Madurai Bench whereby the court vide its order dated 14.06.2024 has directed that:
 - "3. In this view of the matter, the impugned order is set aside. The matter is remanded to the file of the second respondent. The second respondent shall take a decision one way or the other within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. I make it clear that I have not gone into the merits of the matter."
- 5. The matter was considered by SRC in its 440th meeting held during 03rd 04th July, 2024 wherein the SRC decided to issue Show Cause Notice on certain grounds.

The reply of the institution in response to SCN dated 15.07.2024 was considered by SRC in its 454th meeting, wherein the SRC decided as under:-

- The Online Visiting Team be constituted for inspection of the institution u/s 15 of the NCTE Act for proposed M.Ed course.
- 13. VIDYADHARI COLLEGE OF EDUCATIONAL, WOMEN'S COLLEGE ROAD, BESIDES LIC OFFICE, SRIKAKULAM DISTRICT-532001, ANDHRA PRADESH

B.ED PROGRAMME (ONE UNIT); APS07965

The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time were considered by SRC and SRC observed the following:-

- 1. The institution was recognized vide order F.SRO/NCTE/AP/B.Ed/2008/5863 for B.Ed course of one year duration with an intake of 100.
- 2. After promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the Revised order for two units of B.Ed Course of two years duration was issued to the institution vide dated 26.05.2015.
- 3. Upon the request of the institution, the intake of the institution was reduced to one Unit (50) for B.Ed course vide order No.SRO/NCTE/ APS07965/ B.Ed./ AP/2017-18/94098 dated 21.07.2017.
- 4. The recognition of the institution was withdrawn vide order dated 06.11.2020, as per the decision of SRC in its 390th meeting held on 28th-29th October 2020.
- 5. Against the above decision of SRC, the institution approached the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and as per the decision of the Hon'ble Court, the inspection of the institution was conducted on 25.04.2023 and the VT Report was considered by SRC in its 443rd meeting held on 19th-20th September 2024 wherein the Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on certain grounds.
- 6. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, Show Cause Notice dated 08th October 2024 was issued to the institution. The reply submitted by the institution is given below:-

The reply to Show Cause Notice was considered by SRC in its 454th meeting

wherein the SRC decided as under :-

• The institution has complied with the conditions stipulated in NCTE Regulations, Norms and Standards for an annual intake of 50 students (one unit) in B.Ed Programme. Hence, the continuation order for an annual intake of 50 students (one unit) in B.Ed Programme be issued to the institution.
