Six faculty namely, Sri Maddala Apparao, Sri Chitrapu Srimanikya kumar, Sri Usha Sri, Sri A. Pradeep Kumar, Sri Parammata Yesu babu, Sri JVV Satyanarayana appointed after 09.06.2017 and not qualified with NET, hence are not eligible for appointment as per NCTE Regulations, 2014 (amended vide notification dt.09.06.2017). The institution also failed to submit supporting documents in terms of educational qualification of the faculty and experience certificate of the principal. 2. The institution only submitted FDRs for Endowment and Reserve Funds amounting to Rs. 8 lakhs which is not sufficient as per NCTE Regulations, 2014. 3. The institution did not submit Form 'A' issued by the bank regarding maintenance of FDRs for Endowment and Reserve Funds. 4. As per building plan the size of multi-purpose hall is only 169.55 sqm. (1825.02 sq. ft.) which is less than the requirement of NCTE Regulations, 2014. 5. Details of functional website of the institution has not been submitted. 6. Affidavit as directed to submit vide Final Show Cause Notice dt.04.03.2021 has not been submitted. 7. The institute failed in submission of the bank statement of all individual faculty and institution's bank statement duly certified by the concerned bank showing disbursement of salary through bank Account to faculty as required under clause 10 (3) of NCTE Regulation, 2014. <p>Therefore, the Committee decided to issue Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 before withdrawal of the recognition on the grounds mentioned above to the institution. The institution is required to submit the documents within 15 days from the date of issue of Show Cause Notice.</p>

The Committee also made the following resolutions: -

- a) The Committee thoroughly deliberated upon the issue of existing continuation of recognition to all the Government institutions (Universities/Colleges) under the jurisdiction of SRC. It is observed that the Government institutions are running since last couple of years without sufficient strength of faculty members as per the NCTE Norms and Standards. In order to make quality in teacher education, human resource plays a vital role. As the appointment procedure in Government requires some more time, keeping in view of the same the Committee has given



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ample time to the authorities with a request to provide the required number of faculty members to the Government institutions (Universities/Colleges).

Even after repeated requests, it is observed that there is not much improvement in this regard. Therefore, the Committee decided to request the authorities in the Department of Education of all the States and Union Territories to address the issue of providing the teaching faculty to all the Government institutions (Universities/Colleges) of Teacher Education immediately.

Therefore, the Committee resolved to instruct the Regional Director to write to the Education Secretaries of all the States and Union Territories to comply with the Teaching staff requirements as per the NCTE Norms and Standards from time to time.
