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***(e) Until such time as the afore exercise is completed and the resultant order/s communicated to the petitioners, they will be allowed to continue; for which purpose, I further order that all action under the impugned orders in these cases shall stand deferred.***

***I am persuaded to issue the directions above also because it is conceded that, even as per the impugned orders, the petitioners can continue their course until the closure of the academic year 2023-24."***

Further, the Court also directed that all action under the impugned orders in these cases shall stand deferred. As per decision of the SRC taken in its 419<sup>th</sup> meeting, the institution was required to submit the following documents:-

- (i) A copy of application for recognition which was submitted to SRC.
- (ii) A copy of LOI, if issued.
- (iii) A copy of formal recognition order, if issued.
- (iv) The copies of documents enclosed along with the application submitted for obtaining recognition to the SRC.

The Committee observed that the institution has not submitted documents pertaining to grant of recognition by the SRC in terms of decision taken by the SRC in its 419<sup>th</sup> meeting.

Admittedly the recognition was not granted to the institution by the SRC for B.P.Ed. & M.P.Ed. programmes and at this stage the application for grant of recognition cannot be considered in the light of 55<sup>th</sup> GB decision taken by the Council which are as under:--

**"In light of the above, the Council decided the following: -**

- (i) ***At present, there are several institutions which have been recognised by the Regional Committees of NCTE wherein Diploma level courses/programmes are running. An Expert Committee be constituted to devise the modalities for conversion of these recognised institutions into multidisciplinary institutions in line with NEP 2020.***
- (ii) ***The applications pending before the RCs for the said Diploma level course(s) shall not be processed further. Hence, all such pending applications before RCs at any stage of processing be returned along with the processing fee to the concerned***

	<p><b>6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the request made by the learned Senior counsel for petitioner, this Court without interfering with the impugned orders, permit the petitioners to make an appropriate application for getting approval for the courses viz., B.P.Ed., and B.Ed., with the second respondent for the academic year 2024-2025 within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. For making of such application, the second respondent is directed to open the web portal for receiving the application for the academic year 2024-2025 and process the same and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law in terms the NCTE Regulations.</b></p> <p><b>7. With the above directions, both the writ petitions are disposed of. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.”</b></p> <p>The Committee observed that the said writ petition was not decided on the merits of the case. However, the permission was granted to the institution to make a fresh application for recognition/approval and the respondent was also directed to re-open the web portal. Furthermore, the adjudication regarding the opening of web portal is pending before the Hon’ble High Court of Delhi, LPA No. 507 of 2022.</p> <p>In view of the above, Committee decided to direct the Standing Counsel, NCTE, Chennai to file an Appeal before the Hon’ble High Court of Madras.</p>
