At the outset Sh. Madan Singh Yadav, Regional Director and Convener, SRC welcomed the Chairperson and all other members, apprised about the work done by the SRC along with the directions received from NCTE Hqrs. from time to time.

The Committee has taken up the following agenda items of 416th (Emergent) Meeting.

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Committee considered the report submitted by VT members and also considered the faculty list submitted by the institution and found that the institution does not have sufficient number of faculty in terms of NCTE Regulations 2014 as some of the faculty members appointed by the institution are Guest faculty which is not permissible under NCTE Regulations 2014.

The Committee further noted that a corrigendum dated 04.08.2015 was issued on the request made by the institution with respect to the intake of one basic unit i.e. 50 students.

In view of the above, the regional Committee decided to restrict the intake to one basic unit. Accordingly, the Committee confirms the continuation order dated 31.08.2022 issued by the SRC to the institution.

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Committee considered the reply submitted by the institution alongwith the comprehensive report submitted by the Affiliating University and pointed out the following deficiencies.

- On verification of the documents, the Gift Deed Settlement is dated 17.11.2015 whereas the sale deed submitted at the time of recognition is dated 27.03.1998. Both the land documents are different as such the land is not a clear one as per the revenue records. Hence the deficiency identified by SRC, NCTE is unanswered.
- 2. The building plan submitted to SRC, NCTE for seeking recognition of B.Ed. Course is clear, stamps and signatures of the authorities concerned are found correct, but the same plan was submitted to Kakatiya University for seeking affiliation of UG/PG, Non-Professional Courses since 2007-2008 academic year. It is evident from the report of Affiliating University i.e. Kakatiya University, Telangana, the management is showing the same building for B.Ed. also. It is nothing but misleading the university and NCTE authorities.
- 3. The Committee further noted that the Affiliating University has not granted affiliation to the institution for the academic session 2021-2022 as such there was no admission in the institution.

In view of the above the Committee decided to confirm the withdrawal order dated 28.07.2021 issued by the SRC, NCTE and inform the same to the Registrar of affiliating university i.e. Kakatiya University, Telangana.

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Committee considered the reply/representation submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies:-

- 1. The land document submitted at the time of recognition was a notarized Sale Deed in favour of Indira Gandhi Memorial Trust, Survey nos. 83/3, 83/4A, 84/5, 83/5-C, 83/4-B, 84/6, 84/7 situated at Eramallor Village and the present land document submitted is notarized Sale Deed in favour of Indira Gandhi Memorial Trust, Survey nos. 3539/9B4, 353/7/1A, 359/8, 359/9A, 359/10, 358/1A/17, situated at Iramallor Village are different. Change of land and premises without prior permission of NCTE is not permissible under NCTE Regulations
- 2. The BCC submitted is reflecting only Survey nos. 83/3, 83/4A, 84/5, 83/5-C, 83/4-B, 84/6, 84/7 but others survey Nos are not reflected.
- 3. The ownership certificate submitted by the management is not showing any survey no. rather they are giving only building number and ward number etc.
- 4. In such a confusing context the management is asked to submit latest Land Use Certificate and latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by Competent Authority.

Therefore, the Committee decided to issue **Final Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of NCTE Act**, 1993 seeking information to the above observations to take an appropriate decision. The institution is required to submit the documents to substantiate the above within 7 days from the date of issue of **Final Show Cause Notice.**
