At the outset Shri T. Pritam Singh, Regional Director and Convener, SRC welcomed the Chairperson and all members and apprised about the work done by the SRC along with the directions received from NCTE Hqrs from time to time.

The decision may be read as under:- 1. The Committee in its 386 th meeting after perusal of the letter No. RC.No. 359/A/SCERT/2019 dated 29.6.2020 received from
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	<p>the Commissioner, School Education (FAC), School Education Department, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh recommending therein for derecognition order in respect of 188 Pvt.D.El.Ed. colleges in A.P. since the said managements of Pvt.D.El.Ed. colleges have made admissions into the D.El.Ed. course during academic year 2018-19 on their own in violation of Government orders. Accordingly, the SRC decided to issue a Show Cause Notice to all such institutions asking therein to explain about the observations made by the School Education Department, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh vide letter No. R.C.No. 359/A/SCERT/2019 dated 29.6.2020.</p> <p>2. In view of the above decision a Show Cause Notice dt 3.11.2020 for D.El.Ed (AI) and SCN dated 22.2.2021 for D.El.Ed. programme were issued. However, the institution has failed to submit its representation with requisite documents in response to the SCNs issued for D.El.Ed. & D.El.Ed. (AI).</p> <p>Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Sri Pinnamaneni Koteswara Rao College of Education, Plot No.6-127/1, 7th Ward, Mudinepalli Village & Post, Mudinepalli Taluk, Gudivada City, Krishna District-521325, Andhra Pradesh for conducting D.El.Ed & D.El.Ed-AI course with effect from the next academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.</p>
2.	<p>Christ College of Education for Women, Christ Garden, Collector Bungalow Back Side, A. Jetihalli, Dharmapuri District – 636707, Tamil Nadu.</p> <p>(File No. – APSO4841, Course – B.Ed.)</p> <p>In response to the decision taken by the SRC in its 395th meeting held on 25th – 26th February 2021.</p> <p>The decision may be read as under:-</p> <p>The Committee considered the reply submitted by the institution on 01.03.2021 in respect to a letter and found the following deficiencies: -</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The institution has not submitted English translation of Latest Non – Encumbrance Certificate. The institution has submitted notarized copy of NEC in regional language.2. The institution has submitted Building Plan wherein the multipurpose Hall size is not adequate as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.3. The faculty namely Mr. Jayakumar is not having minimum 55%



	<p>marks in postgraduation.</p> <p>In view of the above, the Committee decided to seek the above documents from the Institution by sending a last reminder (Letter) before withdrawal of the recognition on the grounds mentioned above to the institution.</p> <p>The institution is required to submit the representation alongwith a certified/notarized copy of the requisite documents approved by the competent authority mentioned above within 21 days from the date of issue of the letter.</p>

However the institution failed to submit the requisite documents as per Final Show Notice dated 08.01.2021.</p>



Hence, the Committee decided to **withdraw the recognition** granted to **Adiparasakthi Teacher Training Institute, No. 165, Sri Rajasakthi Vinayakar Koil Street, V.P. Nagar, Muthialpet, Pondicherry -605008** for conducting **D.T.Ed** course with effect from the next academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

The land document submitted before the recognition order was Sale Deed with survey No. 1213/2, 1215/1, 1212/2, 1213/1, 1211/2, 1212/1 executed on 28.05.2001 and survey no. 1215/2 executed on 20.11.2002 whereas the land document submitted now is a Sale Deed with survey no. 94/1A executed on 26.05.2003.2. The 'Sale Deed' submitted by the institution shows the land in the name of an individual, which is not permissible as per NCTE Regulations.3. The institution has submitted LUC issued by Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority wherein the survey no. 94/1A was proposed as "Primary Residential Road".4. The institution has submitted photocopy of building plan which is for proposed "High School Building at 94/1A of Kavanoor Village, Madha High School" building. The multipurpose hall area is not mentioned in the building plan. The seal of the approving authority is in also not readable.5. The institution has submitted a copy of the Building Completion Certificate (BCC) which is not in the prescribed format as per NCTE Guidelines nor issued by the competent authority. The survey no. is not mentioned in BCC.6. The institution has not submitted Form 'A' issued by the Branch Manager. The institution has submitted photocopy of 3 FDRs out of which 2 FDRs has been expired. The institution is required to submit Form "A" issued by the bank manager towards creation of FDR of Rs. 7 lakh & Rs. 5 lakhs towards Endowment Fund & Reserve Fund.7.
