The Minutes of the 401st Meetings of SRC were circulated to all members and the minutes are confirmed by the SRC. The Committee taken note of ATR and considered the following items for correction/changes/amendments.

The Committee on perusal of the reply submitted by the ton, decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution Vidya Mandir College of Education, Survey No 107/1B & 108/2B2, Vignesh Nagar, Kotteri, Uthangarai, Dharmapuri District-636902, Tamilnadufor B.Ed. programme for 1 basic unit of 50 students.

3. Kalaimagal College of Education, No.89/2, N.H.46, Atturkuppam Village, Natrampalli Panchayat, Tirupattur Taluk, Vellore District, Tamilnadu.

File No. - APSO4685, Course - B.Ed.

In response to the decision taken by the SRC in its 401st meeting held on 11th – 12th August 2021.

The decision may be read as under:-

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN). The institution has submitted its reply vide letter dated 18.09.2020. The Committee observed the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies.

- 1. The institution applied for shifting of premise at the new location but the same is still not finalized.
- The land documents submitted by the institution is neither certified nor notarized.

- 3. The notarized English translation of Sale Deeds belongs to Survey numbers 390/A/1 and 386/1 whereas the LUC submitted for S.F.Nos 383/1A, 383/1B, 386/1A, 386/2, 387/2B, 387/3A, 390/3A, 390/A/1B, 392/1B, Both do not match with each other.
- 4. The NEC submitted for survey numbers 383/1B2B, 282/1A2A, 392/A1B, 390/3A, 387/3A, 387/2B/386/1A which do not match with LUC and land documents.
- 5. The building plan submitted by the institution is not approved by the competent authority.
- 6. BCC submitted by the institution is not legible.
- 7. The institute submitted a copy of letter dt. 19.03.2020 issued by the affiliating University for approval of Principal only. Vide letter dt. 19.12.2016 One Principal, 9 Asstt. Professors and One Physical Director was approved. The institute did not submit the latest approval of faculty issued by the University. Further, the faculty strength is not enough for B.Ed. course of two Units and proforma of faculty is not legible as signature and stamps of Registrar is not visible.
- 8. Faculty shown to be appointed in 2014 and onward, it is not established that whether these faculty are still working in the college or left? The institution is required to submit Bank Statement showing and establishing disbursement of salary to staff for last five years as required under Clause 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- 9. Website of the institution is not functional and without upload the information as required under NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- 10. Faculty namely R.Elumalai appointed on 15.09.2017 do not possess NET qualification and hence not qualified as appointed after the date of NCTE's notification dt. 09.06.2017.
- 11. The website of the institution is not updated with the information prescribed under para 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.

Hence, the Committee decided to withdraw the recognition granted to Kalaimagal College of Education, No.89/2, N.H.46, Atturkuppam Village, Natrampalli Panchayat, Tirupattur Taluk, Vellore District, Tamilnadu for conducting B.Ed.programmewith effect from the academic session i.e. 2021-2022 onwards under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 on the grounds mentioned above.

4. S.V.S College of Education, Martin Luther School Campus, 208, 15th Main, Nagendra Block, Banashankari 3rd Stage, Girinagar, Bangalore, Karnataka-560050.

File No. – APS03516, Course- B.Ed.

In response to the decision taken by the SRC in its 401st meeting held on 11th – 12th August 2021.

The decision may be read as under:-

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered

A STATE OF THE STA

by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The institution was issued a Final Show Cause Notice (FSCN). The institution has submitted its reply vide dated 23.06.2020. The Committee observed the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies.

- 1. The initial recognition was granted to the institution namely S.V.S. College of Education under the management of Trust namely Sri Venugopal Swamy Educational Trust.
- 2. The Committee in light of letter No. ED476UBV2007 dt. 07.12.2007 issued by the Govt. of Karnataka and letter No. ACA-3/A3/SVSCE:2007-08 dt. 20.09.2007 issued by the Vice Chancellor, Bangalore University decided that the request of the institution regarding change of name of institution from S.V.S. College of Education to Anugraha B.Ed. College is accepted and ractified. The Committee also decided not to allow change in the name of the trust. Necessary change in the website of the SRC, NCTE be made.
- 3. The Committee further decided to issue the Final Show Cause Notice for submission of compliance of adherence of conditions of NCTE Regulations, 2014 be issued to the institution under its new name. The withdrawal order issued as per the decision of SRC taken in the 401st meeting be treated as cancelled.
- 5. Dharma Vidyalaya College of Education, S.F. No. 619, Patta No.228, Poonthottam, Melkalingam Post, Ariyur Nadu, Kolli Hills, Namakkal District-637411, Tamilnadu.

File No. -APS09522, Course -B.Ed.

In response to the decision taken by the SRC in its 401^{st} meeting held on $11^{th} - 12^{th}$ August 2021.

The decision may be read as under:-

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Committee on the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution Dharma Vidyalaya College of Education, Survey No.618/1, 619, Poonthottam, Melkalingam Post, Ariyur Nadu, Kolli Hills, Namakkal District-637411, Tamilnadu for B.Ed. programme for 2 basic units of 50 students each.

The Committee has taken up the following agenda items of 402nd Meeting.

1. Language Pandit Colleges/course in the State of Telangana – Direction of the Hon'ble High Court Order in respect of W.P. No. 5634 of 2019 tilted as Anaganti Bhavani and 8 others Vs. State of Telangana and 7 others dated 29th April, 2019.

The Committee perused the matter pertaining to the equivalence of Telegu Pandit Training Programme offered in the States of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana with that of B.Ed. as per direction given by the Hon'ble High Court of Telangana.

The Committee noted the Govt. of Andhra Pradesh G.O. Ms. No. 80 dated 2.5.2005 interalia prescribed the following General Educational Qualifictoins for the Language Pandit Training courses. :-

a) Telugu Pandit Training Course

- (i) B.A. (Telugu Literature) or B.A. (Oriental Langauge-Telugu) or B.O.L in Telugu
- (ii) B.A. with optional Telugu
- (iii) M.A. (Telugu)

Note: Apart form the above, educational qualifications, a pass in SSC is a must.

b) Hindi Pandit Training Course:

- (i) University Graduation degree with Hindi as one of the full elective subjects or BOL(Hindi)
- (ii) Praveen of Dakshina Bharat Hindi Prachar Sabha or Vidwan of Hindi Prachar Sabha, Hyderabad or any other equivalent recognised qualification in Hindi (B.A Stanadard)
- (iii) M.A. (Hindi)

Note: Apart from the above general educational qualifications, a pass in SSC is must.

c) Urdu Pandit Training Course

- (i) B.A. (Urdu Literature) or B.A. (OL-Urdu) or B.O.L
- (ii) B.A. with optional Urdu.
- (iii) M.A. Urdu.

Note: Apart from the above educational qualification, a pass is SSC is a must.

As this programme is offered in the combined State of the Andhra Pradesh and also continued in the separated states of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh. In order to present the stand of the NCTE to the Hon'ble High Court of Telangana, it is decided to obtain the following information pertaining to the Telegu Pandit or other Language Training

Programme from the competent authority i.e. the Director, SCERT of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh.

- (i) List of the institutions offering this progamme both Govt./University/AidedPrivate Managements
- (ii) For recruitment whether this course is considered as equivalent to B.Ed. or D.El.Ed.
- (iii) The products of such a programme are appointed as Secondary Grade Teachers/Graduate Teachers or Primary Teacher
- (iv) Whether the institutions offering this programme obtained recognition from the NCTE/Revised Provisional Order issued or not in compliance to NCTE Regulations, 2014 of the NCTE

Before arriving at the final conclusion, the above information may be obtained and the matter may be placed before the next meeting of the SRC from both the States. The SRC office shall also placed the status of all the Language Training Programme TEIs.

2. Consideration of proposal from Govt of Telangana -TWD- Telangana Tribal welfare Residential Educational institutions Society(TTWREIS)-Hyderabad – Permission to make an application to SRC, NCTE for establishment of Teacher Educational Institutions exclusively for Tribals-reg. – addressed to the Chairperson, NCTE

The Regional Director, SRC received a request letter from the Special Secretary to Government of Telangana seeking permission to establishment of Teacher Education Institutions exclusively for Tribals. The same was perused by the Committee.

The Committee appreciated the initiative of the Tribal Welfare Department, Govt. of Telangana and unanimously resolved to recommend to the Chairperson, NCTE to accord special permission to the Tribal Welfare Department, Govt. of Telangana for making an application for obtaining recognition for (i) 2 years' B.Ed. (ii) 4 years' BA.B.Ed. / B.Sc.B.Ed. Integrated Programme and (iii) 4 years' Integrated B.P.Ed. programme exclusively for Tribal Students. The Committee also felt that this initiative from NCTE will go a long way to provide quality teacher education to the Tribal Students.

3. Consideration of matter of Teacher Education Centres in Kerala

Offering B.Ed. course without recognition from NCTE.

The Committee thoroughly debated on the existence of teacher education centres in Kerala offering B.Ed. course without obtaining proper recognition from NCTE since last couple of years.

No Revised Provisional Recognition Order (RPRO) was issued to these institutions for running the B.Ed. course of two years' duration as per NCTE Regulations, 2014. Under this circumsntaces the institution are not eligible to contine from the date of promuluation of NCTE Regulations, 2014 i.e. 28.11.2014. Hence the recognition shall stands cancelled/withdrawan with effect from the date of promuluation of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 i.e. 28.11.2014.

The committee viewed it very seriously and decided to inform the Calicut University which is running these teacher education centres to close down them immediately.

Further, the Regional Director, SRC is also advised to write a letter to the Secretary (Education), Govt. of Kerala to direct all the Registrar of Universities in Kerala State not to allow any teacher education centre to offer any of the teacher education programmes in Kerala without obtaining proper permissions from the Govt. of Kerala and the NCTE.

The RD, SRC shall also issue a formal order of withdrawal/cancellation of above programmes as per the above decision of the SRC.

4. Consideration of matters pertaining of 395 D.Ed. Institutions of Andhra Pradesh which have not submitted reply to SCN issued as per decision of SRC in its 401st meeting in compliance of letter No. RC. No.ESE02-22025/43/2020-(SCERT) TRG-DSE dated 25.03.2021 received from Sri V. Chinaveerabhadrudu, I.A.S. Director, School Education, Andhra Pradesh.

The Committee discussed the matter pertaining to the withdrawal of recognition to the TEIs offering D.EI.Ed. programme in Andhra Pradesh as desired by the School Education Department, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh. It is resolved to withdraw the recognition of all such TEIs who have failed to respond to the notice (published on the NCTE website) and also sent to the TEIs through e-mail. The RD, SRC is advised to serve withdrawal orders accordingly.

Further Final SCN be issued to those D.El.Ed. colleges who have replied to the notice and still if there are any deficiency(ies) to comply them within the stipulated time.

5. Central Sanskrit University, Rajiv Gandhi Campus, Menase, Bharathi Nagara, Sringeri, Chikkmagaluru District, Karnataka-577139.

File No. – APS09564, Course - B.Ed.

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The committee considered the request made by the institution for change of name of the institution from "Central Sanskrit University (Deemed University)" Rajeev Gandhi Campus, Menase, Bharathi Nagara, Sringeri, Chikkmagaluru District, Karnataka-577139" in light of the Central Sanskrit Universities Act, 2020 notified in the Gazetted of India on 25.03.2020. The Committee also decided that continuation order be issued to the Institution for B.Ed. programme for 1 basic unit of 50 students.

The Committee further directed to change in the records and website accordingly.

6. Pragathi College of Education, Khasara No. 210, Achampet Village and Post Office, Achampet Taluk and City, Mahbubnagar Didtrict, Telangana

File No. – SRCAPP378,SRCAPP15108,SRCAPP1331, Course – B.Ed., M.Ed., D.El.Ed.

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

- 1. The institution is required to submit certified copy of land documents issued by concerned Tehsildar /Revenue Officer. (If the same are in Regional Language the institution is also required to submit notarised copy of English version of land documents)
- 2. The institution is required to submit an attested/notarised copy of Land Use Certificate issued by the Competent Authority.
- 3. The institution has not submitted a copy of Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Authority. The institution is required to submit an attested/notarised copy of Non Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Authority.

(In case the institution is running more than one teacher education programme, it is required to submit staff list duly approved by the Affiliating body for each of the recognised teacher education programme being run by the Institution.)
- 8. The institution has not submitted original FDRs to the SRC, NCTE The institution is required to submit a "Form A" issued by the respective Bank Manger towards creation of FDR of Rs.7 lakh and 5 lakh, totalling Rs.12 lakh towards Endowment Fund & Reserve Fund into joint account for a duration of 5 years alongwith a copy of the FDRs

- 13. The institution shall be required to submit an Affidavit clearly stating status about land & building and Management (Society/Trust) at the time of recognition and its present status giving following details
 - (i) Details of land & building available at the time of recognition with the Institution.
 - (ii) Details of land & building now available with the Institution.
 - (iii) Status of Management at the time of recognition and its present status.

In case of change of land & building or the Management at the time of recognition and thereafter the institution is required to specify the reason thereof with approval of the SRC, NCTE.

The institution shall note that in case, where the institution is conducting more than one Teacher Education Programme, detail of (i) total build up area available in a composite manner showing the same

in duly earmarked building plan for each of the teacher education programme (ii) latest faculty list duly approved by the affiliating body (iii) FDRs respectively provided for additional programmes is required to be submitted indicating the intake for each programme.

Therefore, the Committee decided to issue **Show Cause Notice u/s 17 of NCTE Act**, 1993 before withdrawal of the recognition on the grounds mentioned above to the institution. The institution is required to submit the documents within 21 days from the date of issue of **Show Cause Notice**.

7. Catherine College of Education, Visakhapatnam Revenue Division, Box# 9, Bheemunipatnam Visakhaptam-531163, Andhra Pradesh.

File No. - APS00346 .Course - B.Ed.

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The committee, on the basis of record, observed the following:-

"The institute at the time of submission of application for grant of recognition submittred a land document of temporary presmise taken on Lease for 5 years (Lease Deed dt. 15.11.2001) with the condition to shift to its own premise within 3 years. A show cause notice dt. 01.09.2009 was issued to the institute for submission of application alongwith fee and other relevant documents. Another SCN dt. 07.01.2021 in time with RPRO and shifting was also issued. Moreover the building plan submitted at the time of recognition and now submitted in response to reply to RPRO is mismatched. The institute in its reply dt. 22.02.2021 submitted that there is no change of land and building since grant of recognition in 2003."

In light of above, the Committee decided to seek a clarification on the above points from the institution before further deciding to cause VT for shifting of premises for inspection of infrastructure & instructional facilities etc. of Catherine College of Education, Visakhapatnam Revenue Division, Box# 9, Bheemunipatnam Visakhaptam-531163, Andhra Pradesh.

8. St. Basil College of Education for Women, Mahendrapuri, Near Housing Board, Vercaud main road, Chinnahirupathi Post, Salem – 636008, Tamilnadu

File No. – APSO6232, Course – B.Ed.

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

The Committee on perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution St. Basil College of Education for Women, Survey No. 2/3,2/3B1A,2/3B1B, 14/4C7, 14/4C8, 28-Block-7, Ward-A, Pallakkadu, Mahendrapuri, Chinnahirupathi Post, Salem – 636008, Tamilnadu for B.Ed. programme for 2 basic units of 50 students each.

9. Balaji College of Education, Anantapur Revenue Division Near RTC Bus Stand, Neeruganti Street, Anantapur District-515001, Andhra Pradesh

File No. - APS00274, Course - B.Ed.

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

Aggrieved by the order of the SRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order No. 89-128/E-182766/ Appeal/16th Meeting, 2021 Appeal No.APPLSRC202113998 dated 07.07.2021 appeal remand back the order appealed against. The institution has submitted reply of appeal remand back case on 24.07.2021. The Committee observed the reply submitted by the institution and found the following deficiencies.

- 1. The institution has submitted Building Completion Certificate in which dated of inspection not mentioned.
- 2. Date of approval on the proforma of faculty is not mentioned.
- 3. The institution is required to submit consolidated Staff list duly approved by the Registrar of the affiliating body as per the prescribed Format approved after issuance of this notice / last reminder. (In case the institution is running more than one teacher education programme, it is required to submit staff list duly approved by-the Affiliating body for each of the recognised teacher education programme being run by the Institution.)
- 4. The institution shall be required to submit an Affidavit clearly stating status about land & building and Management (Society/Trust) at the time of recognition and its present status giving following details
 - (i) Details of land & building available at the time of recognition with the Institution
 - (ii) Details of land & building now available with the Institution
 - (iii) Status of Management at the time of recognition and its present status

In case of change of land & building or the Management at the time of recognition and thereafter the institution is required to specify the reason thereof with approval of the SRC, NCTE.

In view of the above, the Committee decided to seek the above documents from the Institution by sending a last reminder (Letter) before withdrawal of the recognition on the grounds mentioned above to the institution. The institution is required to submit the documents / representation mentioned above within 21 days from the date of issue of the letter.

College for Women, Survey No. 3091, 3105/5, 3105/6, 3105/7B, Ward No.15, Thamaraikulam, Town Panchayat, J.A. College Campus, Periyakulam-625601, Theni District, TamilNadu for B.Ed. programme for 2 basic units of 50 students each.

11. Williams College of Education, No.1-379, APSP Post, Teacher's Colony, Rayudupalem Kakinada-533005, East Godavari District, Andhra Pradesh

The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

Aggrieved by the order of the SRC, the institution preferred an Appeal before the Appellate Authority of the NCTE. The Appellate Authority vide order No. 89-87/E-178609/2021 Appeal/17th Meeting, 2021 Appeal No.APPLSRC202113951 dated 19.08.2021. Till date the institution has not submitted the original / notarized documents for the deficiencies identified by the Appellate Committee and as such the Committee decided to send a notice to the institution to submit the required documents to office the RD, SRC. The recognition of the institution was withdrawn on the following grounds:

- 1. The institution has submitted notarized copy of LUC but Diverted area and Purpose of LUC not mentioned.
- 2. The institution has submitted Notarized copy of building plan but survey No. not mentioned.
 - (i) Area of Multipurpose Hall not sufficient as per NCTE norms.
