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Resolutions passed by the SRC, NCTE: -

- (i) The SRC resolved to direct the Regional Director to write a letter to the Secretary, Education, Andhra Pradesh and also the Chairperson, APSCHE, Amrawati, A.P. with a request to clarify whether there is any policy with the State Government that additional sheets are created over and above the sanction strength by the regulatory bodies in professional courses. It is brought to the notice of the Southern Regional Committee (SRC) that the private un-aided institutions in the State of Andhra Pradesh are making additional admissions over and above the sanctioned strength by the NCTE for EWS. The clarification in this regard is required to facilitate the SRC to take appropriate decision in the matter.
- (ii) The SRC resolved to advice the RD, SRC to write a letter to the Chairperson, APSCHE about the outcome of two emergent meeting held with SRC and Officers of APSCHE in which it was decided to constitute an Expert Committee consisting of a faculty member from the concerned University, one Professor of Education from outside the University within A.P. and one Professor of Education from outside the State. Further it is brought to the notice of the SRC that contrary to decision taken in the emergent meeting some University already started visit to the colleges with their own Committees for extending affiliation.




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- (iii) The Regional Committee advised the RD to obtain legal opinion from the NCTE Hqrs. about the implementation of PAR and the decisions taken earlier by the SRC which were kept in abeyance because of the orders of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi on PAR. Now in view of the Hon'ble Supreme Court order, the NCTE Hqrs. may suggest the action to be taken on the earlier decision of the SRC.
