PUBLIC NOTICE

The National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) is a statutory body established under Section 3 of the NCTE Act, 1993, with the mandate to achieve planned and coordinated development of the teacher education system across the country and to determine and maintain standards for teacher education.

2. In exercise of its statutory functions under Sections 12(j) and 12(k) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the NCTE issued a Public Notice dated 09.09.2024 directing all recognized Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) to submit their Performance Appraisal Reports (PARs) for the academic sessions 2021-2022 and 2022-2023. The last date for submission was initially notified as 10.11.2024 (11:59 PM) which was subsequently extended on two occasions vide Public Notice(s) dated 07.11.2024 and 10.12.2024 with the final timeline being 31.12.2024 (11:59 PM).

3. Despite extensive awareness and outreach initiatives undertaken by the NCTE, several TEIs did not participate effectively in the PAR exercise. Consequently, Show Cause Notices were also issued to such institutions by the respective Regional Committee(s) of NCTE.

4. Thereafter, the respective Regional Committee(s), in exercise of their powers under Section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993, proceeded to withdraw the recognition of various TEIs vide orders citing non-compliance with the requirement concerning submission of PAR.

5. Some of these withdrawal orders have been challenged by various TEIs before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and the Hon'ble Court vide an interim order dated 22.05.2025 in W.P.(C) No. 7008/2025, titled Ram Krishna College vs. National Council for Teacher Education & Anr. stayed the operation of the impugned withdrawal order till the next date of hearing.

6. Further in WP(C)/4366/2025, titled *The Governing Body of Dr. Sarvepolli Radhakrishnan Teachers Training and Research Institute vs. The National Council For Teachers Education (NCTE) And 2 Ors* listed before the Hon'ble Gauhati High Court on 01.08.2025, the Court further passed an order, directing as under:

"List the matter after four weeks on a date to be fixed by the Registry.

In the interim, it is hereby provided that the impugned order dated 14.05.2025 (Annexure-H) shall remain stayed till the next returnable date."

7. In compliance with the aforesaid direction of the Hon'ble Gauhati High Court, the details of TEI namely Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan Teacher's Training & Research Institute, whose withdrawal order has been stayed by the Hon'ble Gauhati High Court, till the next date of hearing is hereby uploaded on the website of the Regional Committee for information of all concerned:
