PUBLIC NOTICE

The National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) is a statutory body established under Section 3 of the NCTE Act, 1993, with the mandate to achieve planned and coordinated development of the teacher education system across the country and to determine and maintain standards for teacher education.

2. In exercise of its statutory functions under Sections 12(j) and 12(k) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the NCTE issued a Public Notice dated 09.09.2024 directing all recognized Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) to submit their Performance Appraisal Reports (PARs) for the academic sessions 2021-2022 and 2022-2023. The last date for submission was initially notified as 10.11.2024 (11:59 PM) which was subsequently extended on two occasions vide Public Notice(s) dated 07.11.2024 and 10.12.2024 with the final timeline being 31.12.2024 (11:59 PM).

3. Despite extensive awareness and outreach initiatives undertaken by the NCTE, several TEIs did not participate effectively in the PAR exercise. Consequently, Show Cause Notices were also issued to such institutions by the respective Regional Committee(s) of NCTE.

4. Thereafter, the respective Regional Committee(s), in exercise of their powers under Section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993, proceeded to withdraw the recognition of various TEIs vide orders citing non-compliance with the requirement concerning submission of PAR.

5. Some of these withdrawal orders have been challenged by various TEIs before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and the Hon'ble Court vide an interim order dated 22.05.2025 in W.P.(C) No. 7008/2025, titled Ram Krishna College vs. National Council for Teacher Education & Anr. stayed the operation of the impugned withdrawal order till the next date of hearing.

6. Pursuant to the above several similarly placed TEIs filed writ petitions before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. In all these matters, the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, while staying the operation of the impugned withdrawal orders, till the next date of hearing, has also permitted the Petitioner institutions to participate in counselling and admit students for the academic session 2025-2026.

7. Further in W.P.(C) 14716/2025, titled **V B COLLEGE OF EDUCATION VS NATIONAL COUNCIL FOR TEACHER EDUCATION & ANR** and other similar petitions listed before the Hon'ble High Court on 22.09.2025, the Court further passed a common order, directing the NCTE as under:

" 14. It is further directed that respondent/NCTE will issue a necessary public notice and upload the list of institutes on its website thereby intimating all concerned, including State authority, affiliating authorities and counselling authorities that operation of the impugned withdrawal order/decisions in respect of such listed institutes have been stayed by this Court and they have been permitted to participate in the counselling and admit the students for the academic session 2025-2026, which shall be complied with. This may be done by the NCTE latest by 29.09.2025. "

8. In compliance with the aforesaid direction of the Hon'ble Delhi High Court, the details of TEI namely **V B College of Education**, of which withdrawal order has been stayed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, till the next date of hearing, and which has been permitted to participate in the counselling process and admit students for the academic session 2025-2026 is hereby uploaded on the website of the Regional Committee for information of all concerned:
