PUBLIC NOTICE

The National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) is a statutory body established under Section 3 of the NCTE Act, 1993, with the mandate to achieve planned and coordinated development of the teacher education system across the country and to determine and maintain standards for teacher education.

2. In exercise of its statutory functions under Sections 12(j) and 12(k) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the NCTE issued a Public Notice dated 09.09.2024 directing all recognized Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) to submit their Performance Appraisal Reports (PARs) for the academic sessions 2021-2022 and 2022-2023. The last date for submission was initially notified as 10.11.2024 (11:59 PM) which was subsequently extended on two occasions vide Public Notice(s) dated 07.11.2024 and 10.12.2024 with the final timeline being 31.12.2024 (11:59 PM).

3. Despite extensive awareness and outreach initiatives undertaken by the NCTE, several TEIs did not participate effectively in the PAR exercise. Consequently, Show Cause Notices were also issued to such institutions by the respective Regional Committee(s) of NCTE.

4. Thereafter, the respective Regional Committee(s), in exercise of their powers under Section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993, proceeded to withdraw the recognition of various TEIs vide orders citing non-compliance with the requirement concerning submission of PAR.

5. These withdrawal orders have been challenged by various TEIs before the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh and the Hon'ble Court vide an interim order dated 28.07.2025 in W.P.(C) No. 19151/2025 titled **Joseph Sriharsha and Mary Indraja Educational Society & St. Mary's B.Ed. College Vs National Council for Teacher Education & Anr.** & W.P.(C) No. 19345/2025 titled **The Proddatur Development Trust & The Rayalaseema College of Physical Education Vs National Council for Teacher Education & Anr.**, has directed the respondents to permit the Petitioner institution to take up the admission for the academic session 2025-2026.
