B.Ed./ B.A. B.Ed. course [prior to omission of the Appendix-13 of National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations2014] into 4-year Integrated Teacher Education programme (ITEP). Its application was rejected. Thereafter, the institution approached to the Appeal Committee and Appeal Committee has remanded back the case vide order dated 08.05.2025 with direction to verify the authenticity of the Multidisciplinary status of the institution from the Affiliating body and then appropriate action shall be taken by the ERC as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations. The Appellant institution has also been directed to forward the ERC the documents submitted in appeal within 15 days from the receipt of order of the Appeal and

after receipt of the same the ERC to take further necessary action as per the NCTE Regulation, 2014, guidelines and amendments issued from time to time. The institution has submitted reply which is received in the office of ERC on 27.05.2025.

- 2. The matter of transition of B.Sc. B.Ed./ B.A. B.Ed. course [prior to omission of the Appendix-13 of National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations2014] into 4-year Integrated Teacher Education programme (ITEP) was considered by the General Body of the Council in its 67th meeting and the following decision(s) were taken by the Council:
 - The final opportunity be provided to all such TEIs including those institutions of which applications were refused/rejected by giving an opportunity to apply afresh online on NCTE Portal. Those institutions which have earlier submitted Transition applications in response to NCTE Public Notice dated 05.02.2024, may be exempted from making payment of processing fee, subject to specifying/mentioning the registration number of the earlier application submitted.
 - ii) The portal be opened as above and public notice be issued with direction to all recognised existing TEIs offering B.A. B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. course (Prior to omission of the Appendix-13) to apply afresh except the institutions which have either already transited into ITEP or have been Issued Letter of Intent (LOI) by the Regional Committee concerned.
- 3. Subsequently, all the institutions were Informed vide Public Notice dated 25.08.2025 that online portal will be opened by the NCTE in Mid-September 2025 and all the institutions concerned were advised to be in readiness to apply afresh with all the required relevant papers/documents including proof of being a multidisciplinary institution as per Guidelines for Transforming NCTE Recognised Stand-Alone Teacher Education Institutions into Multidisciplinary Higher Education Institutions available on NCTE website.

In view of the above, the Committee decided that the institution is required to apply afresh for transition of existing B.Sc. B.Ed./ B.A. B.Ed. course into 4-year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) through the portal when the portal is opened in mid-September, 2025 by NCTE.

After carefully observing the online application form, VT report along with other related documents, the ERC found the following:

- 1 Rajiv Gandhi Central University applied for M.P.Ed. for one unit as per the information furnished by the institution during the inspection, but they have not shown proper documents related to the infrastructural facilities, the institution is advised to collect all the necessary documents, required for approval of the course. in instructional facilities.
- 2 They have limited Resources i.e. Library, ICT Lab, Psychology lab and language lab, they need to establish these facilities in the demarcated building, while the Labs related to Physical Education are well equipped, they are advised to establish and facilitate all the instructional facilities exclusively for the concerned course, i.e. BPED and MPED.
- Classroom seating capacity they need to improve in the same building they are running B.P.Ed. course, the size of the said building need to get more space to open the PG course.
- 4 The Institution needs to establish Toilet facilities.
- The institution is required to establish a departmental library. The institution is having only 3500 Books. More mooks i.e encyclopaedia and manual journals as per norms is required.
- 6 The institution is required to establish ICT lab.

Hence, the committee decided that the show cause notice be issued to the institution to submit the reply through the portal on the deficiencies mentioned above within 07 days from the date of issue of the show cause notice.
