### **Decision of ERC**

The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, NCTE Rules, Regulations, Appeal Order dated 19.09.2025 passed by the NCTE-HQ, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Eastern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following:

- The recognition was granted to the institution for B.Ed programme of two years duration with an intake of 50 students (one basic unit) from the academic session 2025-2026.
- In pursuance of the decision taken by the general body of the council (NCTE), public notice dated 09.09.2024 was issued by the NCTE with the direction to all recognised Teacher Education Institution to submit PAR for the academic session 2021-2022 & 2022-2023 through online mode on NCTE Portal. The last date to submit the PAR was 10.11.2024 which was further extended to 10.12.2024 and subsequently to 31.12.2024 by the NCTE vide public notice dated 07.11.2024 & 10.12.2024 respectively.
- In addition to above public notices, multiple attempts through press release, regular reminder e-mails and video messages of the chairperson and member secretary of NCTE in this regard were uploaded across all major social media platforms for all the recognised Teacher Education Institution for timely Submission of the PAR.
- Despite all directions issued vide above referred public notice, the institution has not submitted PAR for the academic session 2022-2023.
- The matter was considered by ERC in its 362<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on 25<sup>th</sup> March, 2025 and decision taken by the Regional committee to submit written representation before withdrawal of the above recognition/permission under section 17 of NCTE act, 1993 on the ground of Non-Submission of the PAR for the academic session 2022-23 was communicated by the ERC to the institution through online mode on 28.03.2025, a copy of the same was also sent through speed post.
- All the recognized teacher education institution were also informed vide public notice dated 02.04.2025 that show cause notice under section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 is being issued to the institution that have not filled up the PAR by the Regional Committee concerned on the address email of the institution available with the office of the regional committee concerned with the direction to submit their reply within 15 days through online mode only from the date of issue of SCN on the NCTE web portal.
- The matter was considered by ERC in its 366<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup> May, 2025 and committee decided that the recognition granted to Anugrah Narayna College as referred above be withdrawn from the academic session 2025-2026. The Institution is not entitled to admit student in the above referred programmes from the academic session 2025-2026. The Student admitted upto the academic session 2024-2025 shall complete their programme.
- Accordingly, Withdrawal Order was issued to the institution vide Order No. File No. NCTE/2025/ERC/PAR/ORDER/ERCAPP1446/70737-70743 dated 15.05.2025

- The institution thereafter filed an appeal against the Order No. File No. NCTE/2025/ERC/PAR/ORDER/ERCAPP1446/70737-70743 dated 15.05.2025 before NCTE Appellate Authority and the NCTE Appellate Authority decided as under:-

***After perusal of the appeal report, documents on record, Appeal committee of the council concluded to set aside the impugned order dated 15.05.2025 and remand back the case to Eastern Regional Committee for fresh Consideration in accordance with the directions specified hereinabove. The appellant institution is further directed to forward to the regional committee, within fifteen (15) days of receipt of this order, the documents submitted along with the appeal, whereupon the regional committee shall take further necessary action strictly in accordance with law and in light of the directions contained herein.***

- The institution has submitted the reply via email dated 23.09.2025 and 25.09.2025 respectively.

**In view of the above, the Committee decided that the recognition of the institution be restored in the light of decision of Appellate Authority. Concerned affiliating body be informed accordingly.**

**Further, the institution is directed to resubmit PAR upon reopening of the PAR Portal in accordance with prescribed standard operating Procedure, and the Regional Committee shall thereafter take a reasoned decision in conformity with the provision of the NCTE Act, 1993, the NCTE Regulation, 2014 and guidelines issued from time to time.**

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
