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<p><u>Decision of ERC:</u></p> <p>The online files of the above mentioned institutions along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, NCTE Rules, Regulations, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Eastern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The institutions had applied for transition of 4-year integrated B.Sc. B.Ed./ B.A. B.Ed. course [prior to omission of the Appendix-13 of National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations 2014] into 4-year Integrated Teacher Education programme (ITEP). Their applications were rejected. Thereafter, the institutions approached to the Appeal Committee and Appeal Committee has remanded back the cases with certain directions. 2. The matter of transition of B.Sc. B.Ed./ B.A. B.Ed. course [prior to omission of the Appendix-13 of National Council for Teacher Education (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations 2014] into 4-year Integrated Teacher Education programme (ITEP) was considered by the General Body of the Council in its 67th meeting and the following decision(s) were taken by the Council: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i) The final opportunity be provided to all such TEIs including those institutions of which applications were refused/rejected by giving an opportunity to apply afresh online on NCTE Portal. Those institutions which have earlier submitted Transition applications in response to NCTE Public Notice dated 05.02.2024, may be exempted from making payment of processing fee, subject to specifying/mentioning the registration number of the earlier application submitted. ii) The portal be opened as above and public notice be issued with direction to all recognised existing TEIs offering B.A. B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed. course (Prior to omission of the Appendix-13) to apply afresh except the institutions which have either already transitioned into ITEP or have been issued Letter of Intent (LOI) by the Regional Committee concerned. 3. Subsequently, all the institutions were informed vide Public Notice dated 25.08.2025 that online portal will be opened by the NCTE in Mid-September 2025 and all the institutions concerned were advised to be in readiness to apply afresh with all the required relevant papers/documents including proof of being a multidisciplinary institution as per Guidelines for Transforming NCTE Recognised Stand-Alone Teacher Education Institutions into Multidisciplinary Higher Education Institutions available on NCTE website.

4. Later on, a Public Notice bearing file no. .NCTE-RegIO121712025-Reg. Sec-HQ dated 12.09.2025 was issued *interalia* intimating that portal is open from 15.09.2025 to 05.10.2025.


In view of the above, the Committee decided that the institution is required to apply afresh for transition of existing B.Sc. B.Ed./ B.A. B.Ed. course into 4-year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) through the portal as the portal is open now. Accordingly concerned TEIs may be intimated the Committee decision through email.

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Decision of ERC:

The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, NCTE Rules, Regulations, Delhi High Court's Order dated 24.09.2025, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Eastern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

- The institute was recognized by ERC for two basic units (100 seats).The said recognition was withdrawn vide order dated 27.06.2019 by the ERC. The said order was challenged by the institution by preferring an appeal before the Appellate Committee, NCTE, which also came to be dismissed vide order dated 26.09.2021. Thereafter, the institution filed a writ petition being W.P.(C)10473/2020 assailing the order of withdrawal as well as the order of the Appellate Committee.
- Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide its judgment dated 16.12.2020 allowed the writ Petition of the institution and quashed the order of Appellate Committee dated 26.09.2019 and remanded the matter back to the Appellate Committee to Consider the matter afresh.
- On remand, the Appellate Committee again rejected the Statutory Appeal vide order its dated 22.01.2021. Thereafter, the institution filed a writ Petition being W.P.(C)1082/2021, which came to be dismissed vide Judgment dated 06.05.2021. The said judgment of the learned Single Judge was assailed by the institution by preferring an intra-court appeal being LPA No.460/2021.
- The Hon'ble Division Bench vide its interim order dated 17.01.2022 passed in LPA 460/2021 directed NCTE to inspect the building of the institute.
- As the inspection report found that the infrastructure is adequate, the NCTE restored the recognition of the institute qua 50 seats (one Basic unit) on 01.03.2023. In so far as remaining 50 seats are concerned, restoration was declined vide order dated 08.02.2024.
- In the above backdrop, a Writ Petition W.P(C) 12997/2024 was filed by the institution and Hon'ble High Court of Delhi passed the judgement dated 24.09.2025, operative part of the same is as below:

"10. In that view of the matter, petition is allowed and the impugned letter dated 08.02.2024 issued by respondent no.2 is quashed and set aside. Consequently the following directions are passed:

- a) The respondents are directed to restore the recognition of the petitioner institute qua remaining 2nd unit of 50 seats within 10 days from today.
- b) The respondents shall communicate the fact of restoration to the affiliating university as well as the State Authority, i.e., Government of Assam, within a period of two weeks after the passing of order of restoration.
- c) The respondents shall also update their website within one week from the date of restoration.

11. Pending application stands disposed of."

In view of the above, the Committee decided to restore the 2nd unit of 50 seats and copy of the restoration order also be endorsed to affiliating university as well as the State Authority, i.e., Government of Assam. IT Division, NCTE be also requested to update website accordingly.


- The recognition of the institution was granted for B.Ed. Course with 100 seats (i.e. two basic units). Subsequently, vide order dated 08.06.2023, the recognition was withdrawn on account of not having adequate number of faculties. The appeal preferred by institution against the said order was also dismissed by the Appellate Committee vide order dated 27.02.2024.
- The institute filed a WP(C) no. 9840/2024 challenging the withdrawal order dated 08.06.2023 and appeal order order 27.02.2024. Accordingly, the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi passed a Judgement dated 24.09.2025, operative part of the same is as below:

3. In view of the above, the present petition is allowed.

4. Accordingly, impugned order dated 08.06.2023 passed by ERC and the order 27.02.2024 passed by the Appellate Committee are quashed.

5. Consequently, respondent no.3/ERC is directed to restore the recognition of petitioner qua 50 seats (one basic unit) within a period of 10 days. The respondents are directed to communicate to the affiliating university, i.e., Bahasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar Bihar University as well as the State Government within a period of one week thereafter. The

respondents are further directed to update the status of petitioner on their website within a period of one week.

6. Insofar as the remaining 50 seats are concerned, the following directions are passed:

- (i) The NCTE is directed to carry out fresh inspection in terms of Section 13 of the NCTE Act and inform the petitioner institution about recommendations, if any, on the basis of such inspection;
- (ii) In the event any deficiencies are pointed out in the recommendations, NCTE will grant reasonable time to the petitioner institution to rectify the same; and
- (iii) If no deficiencies are recommended, or in case deficiencies recommended by NCTE are rectified by petitioner institution during the time period granted to it, ERC will restore the recognition of petitioner institution for B.Ed. course (one basic units-50 seats), and consequently, NCTE shall communicate about the restoration order to the affiliating university of the petitioner institution, as well as, to the State Government. Further, NCTE will also do the needful with regard to updation of the status of petitioner institution on its website.

7. In view of above, petition stands disposed of.

In view of the above, the Committee decided to restore the one unit of 50 seats and copy of the restoration order also be endorsed to affiliating university as well as the State Authority. IT Division be also requested to update the website accordingly. Insofar as the remaining 50 seats are concerned, NCTE-HQ be requested to carry out the inspection in terms of Section 13 of the NCTE act as directed by the Hon'ble High Court. After the receipt of the inspection report, the Committee will follow the instructions as ordered by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi.

After perusal of the appeal report, documents on record, and oral argument advanced during the online hearing, Appeal committee of the council concluded to set aside the impugned order dated 14.07.2025 and remand back the case to Eastern Regional Committee with the directions to verify the documents submitted in Appeal and then appropriate action shall be taken by the ERC as per provision of the NCTE Regulation. The appellant institution is directed to forward to the ERC the documents submitted in within fifteen (15) days of receipt of the order of the appeal and after receipt of the same the ERC to take further necessary action as per NCTE Regulation 2014 guidelines and amendments issued from time to time as per direction given herein above.

- In compliance of the appeal order the institution has submitted its reply dt. 19.09.2025 and 21.09. 2025.

Decision of ERC

The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, NCTE Rules, Regulations, Appeal Order passed by the NCTE-HQ, reply of SCN along with documents sought by the CP/ERC from the institution, SOP, guidelines issued from time to time were placed before the Eastern Regional Committee and the Committee observed the following: -

- The recognition was granted to the institution for B.Ed programme with intake of two units from the academic session 2015-2016.
- The recognition of the B.Ed programme was withdrawn by ERC due to certain reason as per decision of ERC-NCTE in its meeting 368th held on 17th and 18th June, 2025.
- Accordingly, Withdrawal Order was issued to the institution vide Order dated 14.07.2025
- The institution has filed an appeal against the order No. F.No.368.2/NCTE/ERCAPP696. B.Ed./JH/2025/71308-71314 dated 14.07.2025 before NCTE Appellate Authority and the NCTE Appellate Authority decided as under:-

After perusal of the appeal report, documents on record, and oral argument advanced during the online hearing, Appeal committee of the council concluded to set aside the impugned order dated 14.07.2025 and remand back the case to ERC with the directions to carefully re-examine the matter verify the authentication and relevance of all document submitted and pass a reasoned order strictly in accordance with the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules and Regulations. The appellant institution is directed to forward to the ERC the documents submitted in within fifteen (15) days of receipt of the order of the appeal and after receipt of the same the ERC to take further necessary action as per NCTE Regulation 2014 guidelines and amendments issued from time to time as per direction given herein above.

- In compliance of the appeal order, the institution has submitted the reply dated 30.09.2025, received in O/o ERC through Whatsapp of CP/ERC.

The Committee scrutinized the documents decided that the recognition of the institution be restored in the light of decision of Appellate Authority for B.Ed programme. Concerned affiliating body be informed accordingly.
