Decision of WRC:

The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

- (i) Reply from District Magistrate, Sikar in response to WRC letter dated 08.05.2025 is awaited.
- (ii) Reply from Commissioner, College Education, Government of Rajasthan in response to WRC letter dated 08.05.2025 is awaited.
- (iii) Reply from Registrar, Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Shekhawati University, in response to WRC letter dated 08.05.2025 is awaited.
- (iv) Reply from Registrar University of Rajasthan in response to WRC letter dated 08.05.2025 is awaited.
- (v) Reply from Director, SCERT, Udaipur in response to WRC letter dated 08.05.2025 is awaited.
- (vi) In response to WRC letter dated 08.05.2025, reply received on 20.06.2025 from the institution with comments furnished on the complaint matter vide letter dated 06.06.2025.
- (vii) Subsequently, letter dated 23.06.2025 was received on 25.06.2025 from the institution along with court order dated 17.06.2025 in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 11972/2025 passed by High Court of Judicature for Rajasthan at Jodhpur. The operative part of court order is as under:

“...9. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondents have not given an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner-society. He argued that no order for inspection can be passed on the repeated complaints of the same person and without deciding the representation preferred by the petitioner-society. Therefore, he prayed that during the pendency of the writ petition, effect and operation of the impugned decision taken by the respondent No.4 in its meeting of WRC, dated 08.05.2025 in respect to the petitioner institutions and 23.05.2025 along with order dated 01.01.2024 and 11.01.2024 may kindly be stayed and the respondents be restrained from carrying out de-novo inspection and also to restrain them from taking any coercive action against the petitioner.

10. Issue notice. Issue notice of stay application also, returnable within a period of six weeks.

11. In the meanwhile and till further orders, the communication dated 23.05.2025 (Annexure-10) shall remain stayed and the respondents are restrained from any coercive action against the petitioner-institutions.”

In view of the above, the Committee decided as under:

- (1) **Reminder be issued to District Magistrate, Sikar along with copy of previous communication to submit reply/report within 15 days from the date of issue of letter.**
- (2) **Reminder be issued to Commissioner, College Education, Government of Rajasthan along with copy of previous communication to submit reply/report within 15 days from the date of issue of letter.**
- (3) **Reminder be issued to Registrar, Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Shekhawati University along with copy of previous communication to submit reply/report within 15 days from the date of issue of letter.**
- (4) **Reminder be issued to Registrar University of Rajasthan along with copy of previous communication to submit reply/report within 15 days from the date of issue of letter.**
- (5) **Reminder be issued to Director, SCERT, Udaipur along with copy of previous communication to submit reply/report within 15 days from the date of issue of letter.**
- (6) **This matter being pending for a long period of time and three times inspection conducted (not further taken up) and several times court directions are received with legal implications, the Committee decided that State Controlling Authorities are essentially required to intervene in this matter for early disposal of complaint and recognition related aspects in respect of institutions expeditiously. Accordingly, the Chief Secretary, Government of Rajasthan be requested to expedite the matter and give necessary directions to District Magistrate, Sikar to cause inspection of various teacher education programmes (B.Ed., D.El.Ed., BA. B.Ed. / B.Sc. B.Ed. Integrated, Shiksha Shastri) being run by the Society viz. Deen Dayal Shiksha Evam Anusandhan Samiti, VPO-Bari, Tehsil-Fatehpur, Shekhawati, District- Sikar, Rajasthan-332301 with correct measurement of land in possession of the Society to run the different courses recognized by NCTE in reference to complaint against the institution. A detailed report of the State Government of Rajasthan within 21 days will facilitate WRC in taking appropriate decision in light of NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Guidelines issued from time to time. On receipt of reply/report from the State Government of Rajasthan, the matter be placed in WRC meeting.**

Decision of WRC:

The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee decided as under:

- (1) Reply not received from State Govt of Rajasthan. Reminder letter in continuation of letter dated 18.03.2025 be issued to Commissioner, Department of College Education, Govt. of Rajasthan to submit reply within 21 days from date of the issue of the letter.**
- (2) Reply of First SCN u/S 17 dated submitted vide letter dated 03.04.2025 received on 10.05.2025 from the institution was considered and it is found that the institution is still deficient on the following grounds of SCN:**
 - (i) The institution has submitted Blueprint of Site Plan approved by Deputy Town Planner Udaipur, Rajasthan and Building Plan Khasra No. 1925MI, 1928, 1930, 1931, 2010, 2011, 5629/1929 total land area 2.39 hect. approved by Secretary, PWD, Udaipur, Rajasthan. However, building plan is not approved by local Govt. authority and not mentioned date in the submitted Building Plan.
 - (ii) The institution has submitted Site Plan approved by Secretary, PWD, Udaipur, Rajasthan but not mentioned date therein.
 - (iii) The institution has submitted Govt. lease deed (Patta) approved by O.S.D. Nagar Vikas Pareayas, Udaipur, Rajasthan dated 30.07.2013, however it has not submitted CLU issued by the Competent Government Authority.
 - (iv) The institution has submitted Govt. lease deed (Patta) approve by O.S.D. Nagar Vikas Pareayas, Udaipur, Rajasthan dated 30.07.2013, however, it has not submitted Mutation Certificate indicating Survey/Plot/Khasra No. issued by the Competent Government Authority.
 - (v) The institution has not submitted Building safety certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority.
 - (vi) The institution has submitted Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Chief Officer, Nagar Vikash, Udaipur, Rajasthan, however, it has not submitted Online Fire Safety Certificate in prescribed format verifiable through Fire NOC portal of Govt. of Rajasthan.
 - (vii) The institution has submitted certificate to the effect that the Building is differently abled friendly approved by Sahayak Abhiyanta, PWD, Sub Division-I/II, Udaipur, Rajasthan dated 16.09.2019. Latest disabled friendly certificate is not attached.
 - (viii) The institution has submitted Building Completion Certificate signed by Sahayak Abhiyanta, Lock Nirman Vikash, Udaipur, Rajasthan, however, the same is not signed by the Local Govt. authority and date not mentioned therein.
 - (ix) The institution has submitted latest/current faculty list approved by Registrar, Pacific Academy of Higher Education & Research University, Udaipur, Rajasthan. But list of faculty is not in the NCTE prescribed format as required under provisions of NCTE Norms and Regulation and same is not submitted in original with the details of their teaching subject, date of birth, date of selection/appointment, date of joining, academic qualifications, teaching experience, NET/Ph.D. (NCTE's GoI dated 09.06.2017), salary structure and related documents duly attested by authorized representative of management along with copy of approval letter of affiliating body.
 - (x) The institution has not submitted details of salary disbursed to the faculty along with six months Bank statement and account number of each faculty member.
 - (xi) The institution has submitted FDRs but same is not legible and not submitted Bank Form "A" in original, verified/signed by the Manager of the Bank as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.
 - (xii) The institution has not submitted compliance of all points in light of Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

Final Show Cause Notice u/s 17 (1) of NCTE Act 1993 be issued to the institution with direction to submit reply along with requisite documents certified by the management supported with an affidavit within 15 days from the date of issue of notice.

<u>Decision of WRC:</u> The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time along with email dated 12.06.2025 with copy of complaint dated 25.06.2024, copy of letter dated 11.06.2025 of Additional Commissioner, Commissionerate, College Education, Government of Rajasthan constituting Visiting Team for inspection of the institution against the complaint by State Government and related documents. <u>Decision of WRC:</u> The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under: (i) Application seeking grant of recognition for B.Ed. course dated 29.12.2005 (File No. RJ-848) in the name of Sant Sh. Pran Nath Parnami B.Ed. College, Ward No. 9, Padampur, Sriganganagar- 335041. (ii) Inspection of institution was conducted on 22.06.2007 in the name of Sant Sri Pran Nath B.Ed. College, Ward No. 6, New Dhan Mandi Road, Padampur, Sriganganagar. (iii) Recognition for B.Ed. course was granted in the name of Sant Shri Prannath B.Ed. The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

- (i) As per application, the name of affiliating body mentioned as University of Bikaner.
- (ii) As per VT Report dated 25.05.2007, the name of affiliating body mentioned as University of Bikaner.
- (iii) As per letter of intent prior to recognition issued dated 02.07.2007, the name of affiliating body mentioned as University of Bikaner.
- (iv) Recognition was granted for B.Ed. Course of one year duration with annual intake of 100 vide order dated 10.07.2007 mentioning the name of affiliating body as University of Jaipur, Jaipur, Rajasthan.
- (v) Revised recognition order for B.Ed. course of two year duration in pursuance of NCTE Regulations, 2014 was issued dated 29.05.2015 wherein name of affiliating body mentioned as University of Rajasthan.

Decision of WRC:

The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

- (i) Recognition was granted for B.Ed. Course with annual intake of 100 vide order dated 12.08.2008 followed by Revised order dated 21.04.2015 for compliance of conditions mentioned therein.
- (ii) Shifting of institution from old premises to new premises bearing address: Khasra No. 955/2, Village-Mohana, Tehsil-Sanganer, District-Jaipur, Rajasthan, has been permitted vide order dated 09.02.2018.
- (iii) Based on complaint received against institution, as decided by WRC in its 316th Meeting held on 27th – 28th August & 04 September, 2020, Show Cause Notice u/S 17 was issued dated 05.11.2020 of which institution submitted its reply vide letter dated 05.12.2020

received on 09.12.2020.

- (iv) Based on another verified complaint received against institution, WRC in its 410th Meeting held on 30th – 31st December, 2024 decided that reply of SCN u/S 17 vide letter dated 05.12.2020 received on 09.12.2020 is to be scrutinized together with complaint against the institution and be placed in the WRC meeting.
- (v) WRC in its 413th Meeting held on 27th – 29th January, 2025 considered the matter and as decided letters were issued dated 18.03.2025 to the Commissioner, Department of College Education, Government of Rajasthan and Affiliating Body i.e. Registrar, University of Rajasthan seeking comments on the allegations made by the Complainant in the complaint and to furnish report in this regard.
- (vi) The institution was issued Final SCN u/S 17 dated 18.03.2025 on the following grounds:
 - a) The institution is required to submit the latest Fire Safety Certificate issued in favour of the institution issued through online LSG portal, Government of Rajasthan.
 - b) The institution is required to submit latest/current faculty list approved & signed each page by concerned Registrar of affiliating body in original with the details of their teaching subject, date of birth, date of selection/appointment, date of joining, academic qualifications, teaching experience, NET/Ph.D. (NCTE's GoI dated 09.06.2017), salary structure and related documents duly attested by authorized representative of management along with copy of approval letter of affiliating body.
 - c) The institution is required to submit notarized original affidavit on Rs.100/- on non-judicial stamp paper by the management and Rs.10/- non-judicial stamp paper by each selected/appointed faculty in the NCTE prescribed proforma.
 - d) The institution is required to submit details of salary disbursed to the faculty along with six months Bank statement and account number of each faculty member.
 - e) The institution is required to furnish comments on the allegations made by the Complainant in its complaint supported with documentary proof.”
- (vii) The reply of institution vide letter dated 27.02.2025 and 29.03.2025 in response to Final SCN u/S 17 dated 18.03.2025 was considered by WRC in its 432nd (Part-II) Meeting wherein the Committee observed that the institution is still deficient on the following grounds:
 - a) The institution has not submitted Fire Safety Certificate issued by Competent Authority of Fire Safety Department, Government of Rajasthan verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Rajasthan at URL https://lsgonline.rajasthan.gov.in/track_application.aspx
 - b) The institution stated in its reply that approval of faculty is under process. However, the institution has not submitted the latest list of teaching staff approved and countersigned by the Registrar of affiliating body in the prescribed format of NCTE as per qualification contained in the NCTE Norms and Regulations as amended from time to time.
 - c) Copy of Affiliation form 2024-25 in connection with provisional extension applied to University of Rajasthan generated on 24.02.2024 countersigned by Principal.
 - d) Copy of Bank statement submitted without mentioning account details of each faculty.
 - e) Documentary proof on the complaint has not been received from the

institution.

In addition, the Committee observed that no response received from affiliating body i.e. Registrar, University of Rajasthan and State Government i.e. Commissioner, Department of College Education, Govt. of Rajasthan on the complaint matter.

In view of the above, the Committee decided that recognition granted to B.Ed. course be withdrawn u/S – 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic session next following the date of issue of withdrawal order with a copy to State Government, Affiliating Body and all concerned.

The online application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

- (i) The institution has uploaded NAAC Accreditation Certificate 'A' grade valid up to 21.02.2022 issued dated 22.02.2017 (SHRI KRISHNAJI RAO PAWAR GOVERNMENT POST GRADUATE COLLEGE). NAAC Certificate uploaded by institution was valid up to 21.02.2022. The renewed NAAC certificate is not uploaded. The institution has not uploaded a valid NAAC Certificate.
- (ii) The institution has not filled information related to Affiliating Body and its letter of NOC on the online portal.
- (iii) The institution has not uploaded any documentary evidence i.e. initial and latest affiliation orders issued by the Affiliating University for all multi-disciplinary programmes.
- (iv) The institution has not uploaded certified land documents clearly mentioning all the Khasra Nos. issued by Competent Authority of State Government and the building is situated on a single plot.
- (v) The institution has not uploaded Mutation Certificate mentioning Khasra/Plot/Survey No. issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- (vi) The institution has not uploaded Land Use Certificate (CLU) for educational purpose mentioning all Khasra/Plot/Survey No. issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (vii) The institution has not uploaded latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) issued by Competent Authority of State Government indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (viii) The institution has not uploaded Building Plan approved by Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey No., total land area and total built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the
