# MINUTES OF 432<sup>ND</sup> (Part-I) MEETING OF WRC HELD ON 06<sup>TH</sup> – 08<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST 2025

### **Decision of WRC:**

The original file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time along with order dated 15.07.2025 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Bombay, Bench at Aurangabad and the Committee observed as under:

In compliance of Order dated 15.07.2025 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Bombay, Bench at Aurangabad in Civil Application No. 7126 of 2025 in W.P./5378/2023 with following directions, the operative part of court order is as under:

- "...a. Civil Application is partly allowed.
  - b. Respondent-NCTE is directed to issue necessary orders to extend recognition of applicant-institution for academic year 2025-26 and display the same on its official website. The respondent State Authority to issue "No Objection Certificate" to applicant's college.
  - c. It is made clear that aforesaid arrangement is restricted for academic year 2025-26 and applicant as well as respondents shall make necessary publication indicating that admission of students shall be subject to final outcome of writ petition.
  - d. Civil Application stands disposed of in aforesaid terms.'

In view of the above, and in pursuance of above directions issued vide order dated 15.07.2025 of Hon'ble High Court of Bombay, Bench at Aurangabad, Recognition for B.Ed. course with annual intake of 100 is extended for academic year 2025-26 with a copy endorsed to institution and all concerned and status of institution as recognized be reflected on the NCTE website. The same shall be subject to the further order of the Hon'ble High Court in the said writ petition.

#### **Decision of WRC:**

The original file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time along with appeal remand back order dated 15.12.2020 and order dated 22.07.2025 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and the Committee observed as under:

The Hon'ble High Court of Delhi has passed Order dated 22.07.2025 in W.P.(C) 10400/2025 with following directions, the operative part of court order is as under:

"... 9. In view of the above, it is clarified that remand order dated 15.12.2020 passed by the

Appellate Committee will also be read as quashing the withdrawal order dated 18.08.2017 passed by WRC.

- 10. Accordingly, the WRC is directed to pass the order of restoration in favour of petitioner institution for recognition of the concerned course in accordance with law within a period of 10 days from today. The said order shall remain subject to further decision to be taken by WRC.
- 11. A copy of the order of restoration of recognition of petitioner institution for the concerned course shall be communicated by the respondents to all concerned. Once the order of restoration is passed, the petitioner institution shall be entitled to participate in counselling and admission process for the Academic Year 205-26 and subsequent academic sessions. The WRC is directed to update its website accordingly.
- 12. The Writ petition is disposed of in aforesaid terms."

In view of the above, and in pursuance of above directions issued vide order dated 22.07.2025 of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, Recognition for B.Ed. course with annual intake of 100 is restored with a copy endorsed to institution and all concerned and status of institution as recognized be reflected on the NCTE website.

Further, the Committee observed the following:

The institution did not submit compliance report regarding fulfillment of conditions mentioned in the Revised Recognition Order dated 27.05.2015 pertaining to its existing premises wherein recognition for B.Ed. course was initially granted by NCTE.

On going through the case in details, the Committee noted that the institution is required to submit compliance report regarding fulfillment of conditions mentioned in the Revised Recognition Order.

- (i) The institution is required to submit latest original certified copy Land Documents issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- (ii) The institution is required to submit Mutation Certificate issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- (iii) The institution is required to submit latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) issued by Competent Authority of State Government indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (iv) The institution is required to submit Land Use Certificate (CLU) mentioning name of the institution/society, all Khasra Nos./Plot No./Survey No., land area after conversion to use the land from agriculture to educational purpose issued by the Competent Government Authority.
- (v) The institution is required to submit latest original certified Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government indicating name of institution/society, Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land area and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes, if any.
- (vi) The institution is required to submit latest Building Completion Certificate (BCC) in the prescribed format of NCTE (17 points) issued by the Competent Government Authority for all the courses being conducted in the premises.
- (vii) The institution is required to submit Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety

- guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (viii) The institution is required to submit latest Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Rajasthan verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Rajasthan.
- (ix) The institution is required to submit latest Certificate to the effect that the building is differently abled friendly from the Competent Government Authority.
- (x) The institution is required to submit latest/ current faculty list approved & signed on each page by concerned affiliating body in original for all recognized courses separately with the details of their teaching subject, date of birth, date of selection/appointment, date of joining, academic qualifications, teaching experience, NET/Ph.D. (NCTE's GoI dated 09.06.2017), salary structure and related documents duly attested by authorized representative of management along with copy of approval letter of affiliating body.
- (xi) Notarized original affidavit on Rs.100/- on non-judicial stamp paper by the management and Rs.10/- non-judicial stamp paper by individual selected/appointed faculty in the NCTE prescribed proforma.
- (xii) The institution is required to submit details of salary disbursed to the faculty along with six months Bank statement and account number of each faculty member.
- (xiii) The institution is required to submit copies of valid Fixed Deposit Receipts issued by Nationalized/ Scheduled Bank towards Endowment Fund (Rs.5.00 lakh) & Reserve Fund (Rs.7.00 lakh) in the joint operation mode with Regional Director, WRC, NCTE and the Management along with duly filled Bank Form "A" in original, verified/signed by the Manager of the Bank as per NCTE Regulations, 2014 for each recognized teacher education course separately.
- (xiv) The institution is required to submit compliance regarding all laid down conditions in light of Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

The Committee decided that Show Cause Notice u/S 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institution with direction to comply all conditions in pursuance of revised recognition order and submit reply with relevant documents certified by the management supported with an affidavit within 21 days from the date of issue of the Notice.

### **Decision of WRC:**

The original files of the institution along with other related documents were carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and order dated 21.07.2025 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Judicature for Rajasthan Bench at Jaipur and the Committee observed as under:

The Hon'ble High Court of Judicature for Rajasthan Bench at Jaipur has passed Order dated 21.07.2025 in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 10783/2025 with following directions, the operative part of court order is as under:

- "...3. Per contra, learned counsel for the NCTE opposed the arguments raised by counsel for the petitioners and submitted that the petitioner No.2-College is not having permanent faculty since 1998 and at present also, there is no permanent staff, available with the petitioner No.-2 College. Hence, under such circumstances, the impugned orders have been passed, which require no interference of this Court.
- 4. Heard and considered the submissions made at Bar and perused the material available on the record.
- 5. Matter requires consideration.
- 6. Issue notice to the respondent No.3 alone, returnable by 19.08.2025.
- 7. In the meantime, the effect and operation of the impugned orders shall remain stayed for a period of three months from today. The NCTE is directed to grant provisional affiliation to the petitioner No.2-College and the respondents are directed to provisionally permit the petitioner No.2-College to participate in the counselling process of PTET and accordingly, allot the students. It is made clear that in case, the permanent faculty is not deputed in the petitioner No.2-College in the intervening period, the students, so admitted in the petitioner No.2-College, would be transferred to other College.
- 8. Accordingly, the stay application stands disposed of."

As per the direction of the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature for Rajasthan Bench at Jaipur passed vide order dated 21.07.2025 in S.B. Writ Petition No.10783/2025, the Committee decided that the respective institutions are permitted provisional recognition for B.Ed. course with annual intake of 150 and M.Ed. course with annual intake of 50.

In addition, as per the direction of Hon'ble Court, the institutions are required to appoint permanent faculties as per qualification prescribed in NCTE Norms and Regulations as amended from time to time for each B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses under intimation to WRC, NCTE within stipulated time period. The concerned institutions, State Govt. and Affiliating Body be informed accordingly. The status of the institutions as recognized be updated on NCTE website.

## **Decision of WRC:**

The original file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time along with order dated 28.07.2025 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi and the Committee observed as under:

The Hon'ble High Court of Delhi has passed Order dated 28.07.2025 in W.P.(C) 10920/2025 with following directions, the operative part of court order is as under:

- "... 6. In view of the above, the interest of justice would be subserved if the present petition is disposed of by setting aside the impugned withdrawal order dated 18.03.2025 passed by WRC as well as order dated 09.07.2025 passed by the Appellate Authority of NCTE with a direction to WRC to reconsider the matter. Ordered accordingly.
- 7. Consequently, respondent/NCTE is directed the issue restoration of recognition of petitioners. Petitioners institute will be permitted to participate in counseling and admit students for the academic year 2025-2026 and also for subsequent academic years until and unless a fresh withdrawal order is passed against it.
- 8. The status of petitioner as a recognized institution will also be reflected on the respondent/NCTE's website and will be communicated by the respondent/NCTE to petitioner, affiliating University as well as to the concerned Department of the State Government.
- 9. Respondents are directed to comply with these directions within period of 10 days.
- 10. The petition stands disposed of in above terms."

In view of the above, the Committee decided that in pursuance of above directions issued vide order dated 28.07.2025 of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, recognition for B.Ed. course with annual intake of 100 is restored with a copy endorsed to institution and all concerned and status of institution as recognized be reflected on the NCTE website.

The institution did not submit compliance report regarding fulfillment of conditions mentioned in the Revised Recognition Order dated 31.05.2015 pertaining to its existing premises wherein recognition for B.Ed. course was initially granted by NCTE.

On going through the case in details, the Committee noted that the institution is required to submit compliance report regarding fulfillment of conditions mentioned in the Revised Recognition Order.

- (i) The institution is required to submit latest original certified copy Land Documents issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
