The application for ITEP bearing No.2425202305301784 has already been processed and the same has been rejected for not fulfilling basic criteria vide refusal order dated 17.06.2023 as communicated to the institution through online portal.

The file/related records of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

- 1) Recognition was granted for B.Ed. course with annual intake of 100 (two basic unit) vide Order dated 03.11.2017.
- 2) On consideration of verified complaint against the institution, as decided by WRC in its 421st Meeting held on 05th – 07th May, 2025, Show Cause Notice u/S 17(1) dated 24.07.2025 was issued to the institution on the following grounds:
 - (i) The institution is required to submit the following documents in respect of its land and building located in its existing premises wherein recognition to B.Ed. course was granted by NCTE and copy of the verified complaint letter shall be sent to the institution for point-wise reply in this regard.
 - (ii) The institution is required to upload Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government indicating the Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land and built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land and built-up area for the teacher education programmes.
 - (iii) The institution is required to upload the latest list of teaching staff countersigned by the Registrar of affiliating body as per qualification contained in the NCTE Norms and Regulations as amended from time to time.
 - (iv) The institution is required to upload the bank statement of last six months indicating the transaction of the salary / remuneration to its teaching staff appointed for various courses separately.
 - (v) The institution is required to upload the latest list/details of students admitted for all recognized courses.
 - (vi) The institution is required to upload Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Rajasthan verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Rajasthan at URL https://lsgonline.rajasthan.gov.in/track_application.aspx
 - (vii) The institution is required to upload latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by Competent Authority of State Government.

 - (i) Building plan for Khasra/Plot/Survey No. Killa No. 11/1/0.2050 & 12/2/0.2500 Murba No. 15 Chak 44FF is not approved by the Competent Authority of State Government, wherein not reflected total land area and built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land area and built-up area for the teacher education programmes.
 - (ii) List of teaching staff is not countersigned by the Registrar of affiliating body.
 - (iii) Self-issued letter against Fire Safety Certificate dated 24.05.2025 submitted instead of Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of

- Rajasthan verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Rajasthan at URL https://lsgonline.rajasthan.gov.in/track_application.aspx
- (iv) Self-issued letter for Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by Principal dated 24.05.2025 submitted instead of latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
 - (v) Self-issued letter for Building Safety Certificate issued by Principal dated 24.05.2025 submitted instead of Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.
 - (vi) BCC is not approved by the by Competent Authority of State Government. Total built-up area floor wise, information regarding approval of CLU by Competent Authority of State Government is also not reflected in BCC.
 - (vii) The website of institution has NOT been found operational for cross-checking information in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

Further, the Committee noted that the State Government of Rajasthan has lodged FIR against the institution dated 24.08.2022 and after enquiry by the Competent Authority of State Government of Rajasthan, it was found that the institution has made forgery related to land document shown for B.A. course which was submitted for B.Ed. course. Accordingly, deficiencies communicated vide order dated 22.07.2024 cancelling the NOC by the State Government in respect of institution together with notice issued on 22.07.2024 to the institution with deficiencies for B.Ed. course.

In view of the above, the Committee decided that recognition granted to B.Ed. course be withdrawn u/S – 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic session next following the date of issue of withdrawal order with a copy to State Government, Affiliating Body and all concerned.

Further, it is stated that since B.Ed. course of the institution has been decided as withdrawn, the documents along with fee for shifting of premises, if any submitted by the institution shall not be considered and returned to the concerned institution.

The Committee noted that a complaint dated 03.08.2025 forwarded by Nodal Officer, CPGRAMS of NCTE HQs., New Delhi vide CPGRAMS registration No.DSEHE/E/2025/0008280 regarding serious allegations are made being irregularities about land and building (Infrastructure) and instructional facilities in this recognized institution. The original file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

- (i) The institution is required to submit certified Land Documents issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- (ii) The institution is required to submit Mutation Certificate issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- (iii) The institution is required to submit Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) issued by Competent Authority of State Government indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances issued by Competent Government Authority.

As per the direction of the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature for Rajasthan at Jodhpur passed vide order dated 09.07.2025 in S.B. Writ Petition No.12372/2025, the Committee decided that the respective institutions shall be allowed to take part in the ongoing counselling for B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses. Public Notice be issued for information of State Government and concerned affiliating body.

An application is to be filed for vacation of stay in Hon'ble High Court of Judicature of Rajasthan at Jodhpur by WRC, NCTE.

The State Education Department, of Government of Rajasthan be requested to take appropriate action regarding appointment of requisite regular/full-time faculty in accordance with provisions of NCTE Norms and Regulations for B.Ed. and M.Ed. courses separately and intimate the same to WRC, NCTE at an early date for appraisal of the Committee and to take further appropriate decision.

IV. The other agenda items could not be taken up due to paucity of time.
