The file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

A complaint has been received from the Additional Director Rajya Shiksha Kendra Govt. of MP vide letter No. क्रमांक/राशिके/शि.शि./2025/1757 dated 11.08.2025 a/w Order No.549/आऊशि/संबद्धता dated 09.06.2025 of कार्यालय आयुक्त उच्च शिक्षा, मध्य प्रदेश, the details as under:-

"In the context of the above-mentioned letter from Honorable Former MLA Shri Dhruv Narayan Singh, a request has been made to immediately terminate the affiliation of the D.EL.Ed. course offered by Indira Priyadarshini Mahavidyalaya, Bhopal, in compliance with order number 09.06.25 from the Higher Education Department.

Along with the Honorable MLA's letter, an order from the Commissioner, Higher Education Department of Madhya Pradesh, Satpura Bhawan, Bhopal, bearing letter no. 549/Aadish/Sambaddhta, dated June 9, 2025, has also been received and is attached.

It is worth noting that colleges offering D.EL.Ed. courses are granted recognition by the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE), New Delhi. Based on this recognition, admissions to the D.EL.Ed. course are conducted through M.P. Online for colleges listed in the affiliation list issued by the Board of Secondary Education and the State Education Center.

Therefore, it is a request to take appropriate action in compliance with the letter from Honorable MLA, Shri Dhruv Narayan Singh."

The Committee noted that the State Government has directed the affiliation of the institution and requested NCTE to withdraw its recognition. The Committee decided that the Show Cause Notice u/S 17(1) be issued to the institution with direction to submit reply along with requisite documents certified by the management supported with an affidavit within 15 days from the date of issue of notice.

- (i) The comments of the institution in respect of the complaint made by the Hon'ble M.L.A. and direction of the State Government.
- (ii) The institution is required to submit Certified registered land documents issued by the Registering Authority
- (iii) The institution is required to submit Blue print of approved Building plan signed by the Competent Govt. Authority indicating the name of the course, name of the institution, Khasra No./Plot No., total land area, total built-up area with the measurements of the Multi-purpose Hall as well other infrastructural facilities such as class rooms etc.
- (iv) The institution is required to submit Land Use Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority to use the land for educational purpose.
- (v) The institution is required to submit Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances.
- (vi) The institution is required to submit Certified copy of site plan with demarcated land area for running different courses.
- (vii) The institution is required to submit Building safety certificate from the Competent Government Authority.

- (viii)The institution is required to submit Fire safety certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority.
- (ix) The institution is required to submit Certificate to the effect that the building is differently abled friendly from the Competent Government Authority.
- (x) The institution is required to submit Building Completion Certificate certified by the Competent Government Authority.
- (xi) The institution is required to submit latest/current faculty list approved & signed each page by concerned affiliating body in original with the details of their teaching subject, date of birth, date of selection, date of joining, academic qualifications, teaching experience, NET/Ph.D. (NCTE's GOI dated 09.06.2017), salary structure and related documents duly attested by authorized management representative not submitted. And, notarized original affidavit of Rs.100/- on non-judicial stamp paper by the management and Rs.10/- non-judicial stamp paper by each selected/appointed faculty in the NCTE prescribed proforma.
- (xii) The institution is required to submit details of salary disbursed to the faculty along with six months Bank statement and account number of each faculty members.
- (xiii)The institution is required to submit downloaded copies of documents from the website of the institution with hyperlinks of the same as per provisions of 7(14)(i) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014.

- (i) The institution is required to upload all the list of admitted students for all running programmes along with supporting documents certified by the Affiliating University.

The online application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time along with reply of First Show Cause Notice and the Committee observed as under:

- (i) The institution has uploaded screenshot of data capturing of NIRF Ranking for the year 2023. However, the institution has not uploaded requisite document pertaining to NIRF Ranking Certificate.
- (ii) The institution has uploaded Not-for-Profit Certificate issued by Chartered Accountant. The institution is required to upload Not-for-Profit Certificate issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- (iii) The institution has uploaded a lease deed executed on 10.02.2025 between Shri Sushil Shukla (lesser) and Pt. Harishankar Shukla Smriti Sewa Samiti (lessee) for a period of 30 years of Khasra No. 492/1 of the land measuring 740 sq.mtrs. as per the provision under Clause 8(4) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time, the lease from private party is not permissible. The institution is required to acquire the land on ownership basis or lease basis from the Government.
- (iv) The institution is required to upload Mutation Certificate indicating all Khasra Nos. issued by Competent Authority of State Government.

- (vii) As per the BCC uploaded by the institution, the total land area is 3540 sq.mtr., total built-up area is 3638 sq.mtr. and total land area earmarked for teacher education programmes is 3540 sq.mtr., total built-up area earmarked for teacher education programmes is 3638 sq.mtr. Neither the total land area and total built-up area nor the earmarked land area and built-up area for teacher education programmes is adequate for the existing and proposed teacher education programmes since the requirement of land area for B.P.Ed. course alone is 5 acres as per the NCTE Norms and Standards for B.P.Ed. course (Appendix-7).
- (viii) The institution is required to update and maintain the website in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- (ix) It is also noted that the institution has submitted another online ITEP application bearing no. 2526202404262411 for 12 units for 2025-26 session. The adequacy of land and built-up area for both the ITEP applications cannot be ascertained.

Final Show Cause Notice be issued to the institution for compliance of deficiencies through online ITEP application portal.
