The file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

The institution vide letter dated 20.06.2025 has submitted court order dated 20.09.2024 of Hon’ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi in W.P. No. 13270/2024 with the following directions:-

“1. The present writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, has been filed on behalf of the petitioner, praying as follows:

“(a) direct the Respondent No.2 to constitute the visiting team to conduct inspection of the proposed premises of petitioner institution so as to decide pending application / request submitted by petitioner institution for shifting of premises (D.El.Ed Course), in a time bound manner”

2. This Court has heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner.

3. In the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court directs that the present writ petition be treated as a representation, made on behalf of the petitioner herein, which is to be decided within three weeks from today, under intimation to the petitioner herein, keeping in mind that the interests of the present petitioner is safeguarded.

4. With above, the present writ petition is accordingly disposed of.

5. However, learned counsel for the petitioner is at liberty to approach this Court, in accordance with

law, if any grievance arises.

6. The order be uploaded on the website forthwith.”
