The file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

The institution vide letter Number SPVVPK/2024-25/41 dated 16.05.2024 followed by another letter dated 02.07.2024 requested to correct the name of institution in recognition order as well as web portal from "JIJAV COLLEGE OF EDUCATION (B.ED.), BACHOTI" to "JIJAU COLLEGE OF EDUCATION (B.ED.), BACHOTI."

The request of the institution for change of name cannot be acceded to by the Committee.

Decision of WRC:

The file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

The institution has submitted copy of order dated 02.05.2025 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi

in W.P. Number 8855/2019 vide its letter dated 19.06.2025, 20.06.2025, 25.06.2025 & 24.07.2025 with the following court directions: -

“...22. It appears from the impugned order that the closure application was neither accompanied with NOC from the concerned affiliating body nor there is any recommendation of the State Government.

23. Therefore, the WRC could not order closure of the petitioner college merely because some letter requesting for closure had been received. The WRC was required to adhere to the mandate of the Regulations framed under the NCTE Act.

24. At this stage, reference could also be profitably made to the decision of coordinate bench in Maharishi Dayanand (supra) wherein, a request for closure had been made by a disgruntled Vice-President of the petitioner therein, which led to the passing of order of closure that was assailed in the said case. In this factual backdrop the Court observed as under: “7. Admittedly, the concerned Regional Committee i.e. the Northern Regional Committee (in short “NRC”) acted on the said request made by the Vice-President of the petitioner number 1 society in its 310th meeting, which was held between 20.11.2019 to 22.11.2019, and decided to withdraw the recognition granted to petitioner number 2 institute for conducting D.Ed course with an annual intake of 2 basic units (100 students). xxx xxx xxx

24. The NRC”s cannot withdraw the recognition merely because one person and in this case, the Vice-President of the petitioner number 1 society had approached them.

25. The NRC”s are required to adhere to the mandate of the NCTE Act and the rules and regulations framed thereunder.

26. The NRC, ordinarily, should pass such orders, only if, deficiencies are found in the concerned institute/college. xxx xxx xxx 28. Thus, for the foregoing reasons, I am inclined to set aside the impugned decision. It is ordered accordingly.”

25. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the impugned closure order dated 01.06.2018 is set aside. It is directed that respondent/WRC will re-examine the matter afresh and pass appropriate order apropos continuation of recognition of petitioner institution for conducting D.El.Ed. course.

26. The respondent/WRC is at liberty to ask for the resolution of the general body of the petitioner number 1 society to put at rest the controversy with regard to the genuineness of letter requesting closure.

27. It is made clear that till the decision is taken by the respondent/WRC as regards continuation of recognition, the petitioner shall not take any fresh admissions.

28. The petition alongwith pending application is disposed of.”

The Committee examined the matter keeping all the facts in view and noted that the order for closure of D.Ed. course of the petitioner’s institution was issued pursuant to closure application submitted by it along with resolution of the petitioner’s Society. Thereafter, the Affiliating Body of the petitioner’s institution i.e. Madhyamik Shiksha Mandal vide letter number 1106/D.El.Ed. cell/2019 dated 11.04.2019 has cancelled the affiliation from the session 2018-19.

The Committee also noted that there is an efficacious remedy available for petitioner’s institution to file appeal u/S 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 against the decision of the Western Regional Committee. However, the same was not availed by concerned institution.

The Committee decided to re-affirm its decision for closure of D.Ed. course of the petitioner’s institution.

The sufficiency of land and built-up area for 1470 intake of multidisciplinary courses and 100 intake for D.El.Ed., 200 intake for B.Ed., 50 intake for M.Ed. courses and 24 units (1200 intake) for proposed ITEP cannot be ascertained.
- (v) The institution has uploaded copy of correspondence made with the Bank for salary of teaching staff. However, the institution has not uploaded bank statement of last six months indicating the transaction of the salary / remuneration to its teaching staff.
- (vi) The website of institution has NOT been updated and maintained in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- (vii) The institution has uploaded NEC mentioning its validity for 2023-24 and 2024-25 (for 2 years). The institution has not uploaded latest Non- Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) with all khasra nos. issued by competent authority of State Government for 2025-26 for which the institution has applied for grant of recognition.
- (viii) The institution has uploaded CLU for residential purpose, however it is not for educational purpose.
- (ix) The institution has uploaded Fire Safety Certificate issued on 20.06.2024 valid for one year, which was expired on 19.06.2025.
- (x) The institution has not uploaded Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey Number and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.
- (xi) The institution has not mentioned academic session in the uploaded list of teaching staff.

In view of the above, the application for ITEP is rejected.

The online application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined

in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time along with reply of Final Show Cause Notice and the Committee observed as under:

- (i) The institution has not uploaded Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (ii) Uploaded Building Completion Certificate is not in NCTE prescribed format and not approved by the competent govt. engineer. The institution has not uploaded latest Building Completion Certificate in the prescribed format of NCTE (17 points) indicating Plot/Survey/Khasra Number issued by the Competent Government Authority for all the courses being conducted in the premises.
- (iii) The institution has not uploaded latest Non Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) issued by Competent Government Authority mentioning that the land is free from all encumbrances.
- (iv) The institution has not uploaded Land Use Certificate (CLU) mentioning all Khasra Nos. issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (v) Land in the name of Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited, Bhopal uploaded by the institution. The institution has uploaded letter dated 22.02.2025 issued by Senior Engineer, BHEL stating that: “it is hereby clarified that a plot of land admeasuring 19 acres i.e. 827640 sq. Ft., in the BHEL Bhopal Public premises, has been given on license basis to Sri Sathya Sai Education Society, Bhopal, for running an educational institution known as "Sri Sathya Sai College for Women" at Habibganj BHEL, Bhopal under the terms and conditions as mentioned in the license agreement dated 12/08/2022 which is valid till 31/03/2027.” As per Regulations 2014 Condition of Recognition 8 (4) (i) "No institution shall be granted recognition under these regulations unless the institution society sponsoring the institution is in possession of required land on the date of application. The land free from all encumbrances could be either on ownership basis or on lease from Govt. or Govt. institution for a period of not less than thirty years. In cases where under relevant State or Union territory laws the maximum permissible lease period is less than thirty years, the State Government or Union territory administration law shall prevail and in any case no building shall be taken on lease for running any teacher training programme.”
- (vi) There is no clarity about land ownership. Is the Institution owned the land or is it on a lease? The Institution has not clarified it with relevant documents.
- (vii) The institution mentioned in the application that land is on ownership basis. It has not uploaded certified ownership land documents.
- (viii) Regarding the land, BHEL Bhopal gave a certificate dated 11.10.2019 wherein it is mentioned that the land has been allotted to the Education Society, exclusively for the purpose of running an educational institute by the name "Sri Sathya Sai College for Women". The license agreement with society is being renewed every five year. Further, vide letter dated 22.02.2025 issued by BHEL to the institution, it is mentioned that a plot of land admeasuring 19 acres i.e. 827640 sq.ft. in the BHEL Bhopal Public premises, has been given on license basis to Sri Sathya Sai Education Society, Bhopal, for running an educational institution known as “Sri Sathya Sai College for Women” at Habibganj BHEL,

Bhopal under the terms and conditions as mentioned in the license agreement dated 12/8/2022, which is valid till 31/03/2027.

- (ix) The institution has uploaded list of teaching staff for academic session 2021-22 and 2022-23. The institution has not uploaded latest list of teaching staff (2025-26) in NCTE prescribed format for all recognized teacher education programmes and other courses countersigned by Registrar of Affiliating Body/University/competent authority as well as details of salary disbursed to the faculties/teaching staff for last 6 months.
- (x) The website of institution has NOT been updated and maintained in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- (xi) The institution is conducting degree courses i.e. B.A. with intake 300, B.Sc. with intake 300 (Biotechnology, Microbiology, Computer Science), MA with intake 75 (English, Hindi, Political Science), BCA with intake 60, M.Sc. with intake 125 (Math, Chem, Zoology, Biotechnology, Computer Science), B.Com. with intake 300, M.Com. with intake 80 (Taxation, Management), BA LLB with intake 60, LLB with intake 60 combined intake of 1360. The sufficiency of land and built-up area for 1360 intake of multidisciplinary courses and 100 intake for B.Ed. course cannot be ascertained.

The online application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time along with reply of Final Show Cause Notice and the Committee observed as under:

The online application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time along with reply of First Show Cause Notice and the Committee observed as under:

- (i) The institution is conducting degree courses i.e. B.A. with intake of 240, B.Sc. with intake of 420, B.Com. with intake of 240, BCA with intake of 150, BBA with intake of 150, M.A. (English, Pol. Science = with intake of 80), M.Com. (EAFM, Geography = with intake of 80), M.Sc. (Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology = with intake of 205) combined intake of 1565 (the total students in the campus of all courses is 4330) and proposed 24 units i.e. 1200 intake of ITEP. The sufficiency of land area and built-up area for 4330 in total of multidisciplinary courses and 1200 intake for proposed ITEP cannot be ascertained.

- (ii) The institution is required to upload latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) issued by Competent Authority of State Government indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (vi) The total land area 10.72 acre and total built-up area 2214.18 sq.mtr. mentioned in uploaded Building Plan, the earmarked land area 10.72 acre and built-up area 2214.18 sq.mtr. for proposed teacher education programmes and the total land area 10.72 acre and total built-up area 9,775 Sq.mtr. in uploaded Building Completion Certificate which cannot be factually ascertained. The BCC uploaded by the institution is not approved by the Competent Government Authority. Total built up area earmarked for TE course and name of course is not indicated in the BCC.
- (viii) Affidavit dated 04.09.2025 related to land is uploaded wherein total built up area not mentioned.
- (ix) The institution has not uploaded Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Rajasthan verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Rajasthan at URL https://lsgonline.rajasthan.gov.in/track_application.aspx
- (x) Letter regarding recommendation of State Govt/ UT Administration for proposed ITEP Course is not uploaded. The institution is required to upload Letter regarding recommendation of State Govt/ UT Administration for proposed ITEP Course.
- (xi) The institution has not uploaded Not-for-Profit Certificate issued by Competent Authority of State Government.

The online application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time along with reply of First Show Cause Notice and the Committee observed as under:

- (i) The institution is required to upload Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the name of institution, Khasra/Plot/Survey Number and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land area and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.
- (ii) The institution has uploaded Fire Safety Certificate issued on 28.12.2022 for a period of one year which has been expired. The institution is required to upload Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Madhya Pradesh verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Madhya Pradesh.
- (iii) The institution is conducting B.Ed. (50 intake), M.Ed. (50 intake), B.El.Ed. Decision of WRC:

The file of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

Court Order dated 20.08.2025 passed by Hon'ble High Court of Bombay in W.P.(C) 10998 of 2025 is received and the operative part is as under:-

“...(6) The petitioners have preferred appeal before the appellate authority challenging withdrawal of the recognition. In the facts and circumstances of the present case, we are satisfied that the impugned order of withdrawal of the recognition dated 24.05.2025 is required to be stayed till the hearing of the appeal.”

(7) In light of the above, application for rectification should now be decided by the respondent Number2 within the period of two weeks from today.

(8) In this view of the matter, subject to the decision in appeal, the petitioners can be allowed to participate in the admission process to carry out admission for the Shri Shivajirao Deshmukh Shikshanshastra (M.Ed.) Mahavidyalaya, Shirala, Sangli, and Shri. Shivajirao Deshmukh Adhyapak Vidyalaya (D.Ed.), Shirala, Sangli.”

The Committee noted that the petitioner institution has filed an appeal u/S 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 before the Appeal Committee which is yet to be disposed. The Hon’ble Court has granted stay against the WRC withdrawal order dated 24.05.2025 till the disposal of the appeal of the petitioner institution. With regard to application for change of name, the Committee decided that the petitioner institution is required to submit the same along with NOC of its Affiliating Body, NOC from the State Government and resolution of its parent body/trust/society. On receipt of the same from the petitioner institution, the matter be placed for consideration of WRC.

The Appeal Committee be requested to dispose of the appeal filed by the institution.
