Following reorganization, these institutions came under the ambit of the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2014. In response to the public notices issued by NCTE during 2020-2021, a total of 141 existing Teacher Education Institution (TEIs) from Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh applied for recognition. While these institutions have made considerable progress towards meeting the required norms and standards, many are still in the process of fully complying and require time to fully comply with these new regulations, the deadline for which has expired in 2024.
