36. Consideration of the request received from Hon'ble CM, Jammu & Kashmir for granting further relaxation of two years for the TEIs in Jammu & Kashmir to meet NCTE Standards.

Decision of NRC

The Committee considered the letter dated 15.07.2025 from Shri Omar Abdullah, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Jammu and Kashmir stating the following: -

- i. Prior to enactment of the Jammu & Kashmir Reorganization Act, 2019, the B.Ed. institutions in J&K operated outside the regulatory framework of the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE). Following reorganization, these institutions came under the ambit of the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- ii. In response to the public notices issued by NCTE during 2020-2021, a total of 141 existing Teacher Education Institution (TEIs) from Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh applied for recognition. While these institutions have made considerable progress towards meeting the required norms and standards, many are still in the process of fully complying and require time to fully comply with these new regulations, the deadline for which has expired in 2024.
- iii. Give the vital role these institutions play in teacher training and the potential disruption to education services in the region, it is requested for granting a further relaxation period of at least two years for the TEIs in Jammu & Kahmir to meet NCTE Standards.

The Committee noted that as per the National Education Policy 2020 & Policy of NCTE, all the existing stand-alone Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) offering B.Ed. 2-Year Programme shall be eligible to continue, provided-

- (i) Such institutions transform into Multidisciplinary Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) by 2028.
- (ii) Such institutions shall run ITEP (B.A. B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed./ B.Com. B.Ed.) by 2030.

In view of the above, all the TEIs in the UT of Jammu & Kahmir which have been granted or will be granted recognition by NCTE shall also have to transform into Multidisciplinary Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) by 2028 and also such institutions shall run ITEP (B.A. B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed./ B.Com. B.Ed.) by 2030.

Hence, the NRC is of the considered opinion that these institutions, at this juncture, have enough time for preparation to transit into ITEP as per the existing policy of NCTE. In case, the request made by the Hon'ble CM for granting 2 years more time to prepare themselves to meet the Norms & Standards for B.Ed./M.Ed., is acceded to, then the exercise done by the NRC so far for granting recognition to a number of TEIs will go into vain.

Further such extension, if granted, would imply that the TEIs in J&K will only attempt to prepare themselves for offering their existing courses only whereas they are expected to prepare themselves to transform into Multidisciplinary Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) by 2028 and to offer ITEP (B.A. B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed./ B.Com. B.Ed.) by 2030.
