Hence recognition withdrawn from academic year 2023-2024. 6. The petitioner institute filed an appeal before appellate authority almost after delay of 1.5 years. The appeal order dated 9/7/2025 upheld the withdrawal order. 7. Para 14 of the Writ Petition states that that recognition is withdrawn for running the D.El.Ed programme from academic session 2025-2026 which is factually incorrect as it can be seen from SCN served by the NCTE-SRC. 8. Para 12 of the Writ Petition is erroneous, misconceived and false as the recognition withdrawn from the academic session 2023-2024 in pursuant to the public notice dated 29/9/2021. 9. It is submitted that since the recognition was withdrawn in year 2023, the college was inoperative since then and hence approached the Hon'ble Court after lapse of more than 2.5 years. 10. The petitioner institute claims under para 23 of the writ petition that the PAR report was submitted but there is no evidence in support. |
