12.	<p align="center">CONSIDERATION OF COMMENTS OF THE OBSERVER OF VT (INSPECTION)- SRC</p> <p>The observer of the VT (Inspection) – SRC brought to the notice of the SRC that few members have been repeatedly given opportunity for inspection with respect to the institutions under the jurisdiction of SRC. The SRC considered 22 VT reports conducted in the month of September 2025 and observed the following:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Mr. Biju C. V. has been given assignment twelve times. 2. Dr. Yogendra Babu has been given assignment nine times. 3. Mr. B. U. Ganapathy has been given assignment seven times. 4. Shri. Vikas Namdeo Garad has been given assignment five times. 5. Dr. Dnyaneswar D. Nagre has been given assignment five times. 6. Dr. Mukesh Kumar has been given assignment four times. 7. Dr. Rajendrakumar Lalji Nikose has been given assignment three times. 8. Dr. Rajendra Singh has been given assignment three times. 9. The SRC also observed that the following pair of VT Members given assignment in the month of September, 2025: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Dr. Yogendra Babu & Mr. Biju C.V. = 7 Times b. Dr. Dnyaneswar D. Nagre & Mr. B.U. Ganapathy = 4 Times c. Shri Vikas Namdeo Garad & Mr. Biju C.V. = 4 Times d. Dr. Mukesh Kumar & Mr. Biju C.V. = 3 Times e. Dr. Rajinder Singh & Mr. Biju C.V. = 2 Times f. Dr. Rajendrakumar Lalji Nikose & Mr. B.U. Ganapathy = 2 Times 10. The SRC observed that VT members have to conduct one inspection only in a day, whereas, in these cases, they have conducted two inspection in a day (morning & afternoon). 11. There was also a delay in submission of their reports, which is totally against the VT Policy of the NCTE. <p>In view of the fact that a good panel of experts are available to conduct the VT, repetition of the same experts consistently could be avoided. Hence, the SRC decided that RD-SRC may bring the above facts to notice NCTE-HQrs for further necessary action.</p>
13.	<p align="center">TABLE AGENDA WITH THE PERMISSION OF CHAIR</p> <p>Karnataka State Open University, Mysore – B.Ed (DE) (500 students)</p> <p>The original file of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act 1993, Regulations, Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, the SRC after careful consideration made the following observations:-</p> <p>The University has obtained the approval of UGC-DEB for Study Material for B.Ed (Distance Education) programme</p> <p>Accordingly, the SRC decided that the University be permitted to make admission for the B.Ed (Distance Education) programme with an annual intake of 500 students (One Unit).</p>

General Resolution:

The committee resolved to request the Regional Director (RD) to seek clarification from the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) Headquarters regarding the authenticity and consistency of the contents of the hard copy and soft copy (available on the NCTE website) of the Compendium. Further, the committee wishes to seek clarification from the HQs to confirm whether both versions of the Compendium may be considered as official documents and guidelines of NCTE for consultation and action by stakeholders.

The Committee also noted that as per clause 8(9) of NCTE Regulations 2014, as amended from time to time, it has been specified that the application for shifting of premises shall be submitted online electronically on NCTE portal, accordingly, SRC decided that henceforth the application submitted offline for shifting of premises will not be considered.
