The online application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time along with reply of Final Show Cause Notice dated 21.04.2025 and the Committee observed as under:

(i) The University offers Multi-disciplinary courses other than the faculty which has applied for the courses. The total land area and built-up area earmarked for these courses to be indicated in the Building Plan is not uploaded by the institution. The institution is not offering any course in liberal

arts, science, humanities. As per the details provided by the institution, it is not running multidisciplinary course as per Regulation No.NCTE-Regl011/80/2018- MS(Regulation)-HQ notified dated 26.10.2021 as amended from time to time and Public Notice No.NCTE-Regl012/1/2024-Reg. Sec-HQ dated 15.03.2024.

- (ii) The website of institution has NOT been updated and maintained in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- (iii) The institution has uploaded the details that they offer B.Ed. and B.P.Ed. courses for which they need the built-up area of 3,500 sq.mtrs. The Khasra No. 133/1 & 133/2 where the Faculty of Education is situated, the built-up area is not sufficient for the existing teacher education programmes. Moreover, they have applied for more 6 units of ITEP programme which require more 3,000 sq.mtrs. of built-up area which seems insufficient for existing teacher education programmes and no provision has been observed for any extra space required.

In view of the above, the application for ITEP is rejected.

The online application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time along with reply of Final Show Cause Notice dated 21.04.2025 and the Committee observed as under:

- The Building Completion Certificate uploaded by the institution is not approved by the (i) Competent Government Authority. The institution has not uploaded Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Madhya Pradesh verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Madhya Pradesh.
- (iii) The institution has not uploaded Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (iv) The institution has not uploaded No Objection Certificate from the Competent Authority of Ministry of Defence for introducing new course of Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) notified by NCTE vide Gazette Notification No.509 dated 26.10.2021. It is observed

The online application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time along with reply of final Show Cause Notice dated 02.04.2025 and the Committee observed as under:

- (i) The institution has uploaded multi-disciplinary program in the name Jambukhand college. Kalinjara, Banswara, whereas the name of the institution for proposed course is Jambukhand Teacher Training Institute. Both the names are different. Hence, the institution is not under multi-disciplinary institution.
- (ii) As per the details made available by the institution that the institution has proposed construction of 2536 sq. mtr. for proposed ITEP, whereas institution offers B.Ed. (2 unit) and B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. (2 Units) out of which B.Ed (2 units) required 2000 sq mtr. built-up area so the proposed programme requires 2200 sq. mtr. of built-up area. Hardly 536 sq. mtr. of built-up area is remaining. So the institution has not required built-up area as per Norms.
- (iii) The institution has not uploaded Not-for-Profit certificate. But the institution has uploaded Form-10AC instead Not-for-Profit certificate.

In view of the above, the application for transition to ITEP is rejected.

- (iii) The institution has not uploaded Not-for-Profit Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority.
- (iv) The institution has not uploaded latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Govt. Authority i.e. SDM/TAHSILDAR.

In view of the above, the application for transition to ITEP is rejected.

- (i) The NAAC Certificate uploaded by the applicant institution belongs to PVDT College of Education for Women whereas the applicant institution is "Shreemati Nathibai Damodar Thackersey Womens University".
- (ii) The applications were invited from multi-disciplinary institutions for offering ITEP from 2025-26 so the request of applicant institution cannot be entertained as NAAC Accreditation institution has not been uploaded by the institution.
- (iii) The institution is required to upload latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- (iv) The institution is required to upload Mutation Certificate issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- (v) The institution is required to upload Land Use Certificate mentioning all Khasra Nos. issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (vi) The Building Plan uploaded by the institution is not legible. The institution is required to upload clearly legible Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government indicating the Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land area and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.
- (vii) The institution is required to upload latest Building Completion Certificate in the prescribed format of NCTE (17 points) issued by the Competent Government Authority for all the courses being conducted in the premises.
- (viii) The institution is required to upload Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Maharashtra verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Maharashtra.
- (ix) The website of institution has NOT been updated and maintained in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

Final Show Cause Notice be issued to the institution for compliance of deficiencies through online ITEP application portal.
