Decision of WRC:

The WRC considered the Appeal Committee Order No. 89-64/E-345931/2024 Appeal/1st Meeting, 2025 APPLWRC2024414809 dated 31.01.2025 thereby setting aside WRC withdrawal order dated 17.12.2020 and remanding back the case with direction to re-visit the case in totality as under:

"After perusal of the Appeal Report, documents on record and oral arguments advanced during the online hearing, Appeal Committee of the Council concluded to set aside the implunged order dated 17.12.2020 and <u>remand back the case to WRC with a direction to revisit the case in totality</u> <u>and also to check that the institution fulfil all the criteria of norms & standards for the land & building</u> <u>where the recognition was granted</u> by the WRC as per applicable rules & regulations and decision shall be taken accordingly. The Appellant institution is directed to forward to the WRC the documents submitted in appeal within 15 days from the receipt of order of the Appeal and after receipt of the same the WRC take further necessary actin as per the NCTE Regulation, 2014, guidelines and amendments issued from time to time as per direction given herein above."

The Committee noted that the institution has not submitted the compliance of the revised recognition order issued on 31.05.2015 and carefully examined the matter along with the documents submitted by the institution consequent upon the appeal order in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

- i. The institution is required to submit FDRs in Joint Operation Mode with Regional Director, WRC, NCTE for all the teacher education programmes (Endowment of Rs.5.00 lakhs and Reserve Fund of Rs.7.00 lakhs for each course) along with Form 'A' (in original) issued from the concerned Bank.
- ii. The institution is required to upload certified land documents clearly mentioning all the Khasra Nos. issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- iii. The institution is required to upload Mutation Certificate issued by Competent Authority of State Government.
- iv. The institution is required to upload Land Use Certificate (CLU) mentioning all Khasra Nos. issued by Competent Government Authority.

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Decision of WRC:

The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time the Committee observed as under:

The WRC noted that the Appeal Committee vide its Order dated 04.10.2021 set aside WRC withdrawal order dated 18.12.2020. The WRC had issued the First Show Cause Notice dated 26.05.2022. No reply submitted by the institution to the First Show Cause Notice. The recognition of the institution was restored vide order dated 10.04.2024 and Final Show Cause Notice dated 12.04.2024 issued to the institution and reply submitted by the institution vide letter dated 23.04.2024 was found deficient on the following grounds:

i. The institution has submitted a copy of letter dated 07.10.2008, mentioning therein that it has shifted to its own premises from rental building. However, the letter dated 07.10.2008

along with the documents submitted thereto, are not available in the Physical and e-file of the institution.

- ii. As per letter dated 07.10.2008 of the Society of the institution, it informed that the society had shifted building of the institution into its own premises without the permission of WRC, NCTE.
- iii. As per record, D.Ed. and M.Ed. courses granted recognition in the name of T.D. D.Ed. College and B.Ed. course in the name of T.D. Education College at the same premises, address and location.
- iv. B.Ed. course of the institution shifted to new location/address/premises without the permission of WRC, NCTE.
- v. Inspection of the institution u/s-17 of NCTE Act, 1993 as amended from time to time was conducted between 15.04.2009 to 20.04.2009 for B.Ed. course. However, it has emerged from the inspection that the institution is conducting B.Ed. courses in the name of T.D. Education College at Chakghat, Allahabad Road Teonthar, Rewa, Madhya Pradesh and it is conducting D.Ed. (D.El.Ed.) and M.Ed. courses in the name of T.D. D.Ed. College at Chakghat, Allahabad Road Teonthar, Rewa, Madhya Pradesh. Further, it is noted that both the institutions are functioning from the same premises and at the same location/address.

In view of the above, the Committee decided that recognition granted to (a) T.D. Education College, Chakghat, Allahabad Road Teonthar, Rewa, Madhya Pradesh for B.Ed. course and (b) T.D. D.Ed. College for D.Ed. (D.El.Ed.) and M.Ed. courses be withdrawn u/S – 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 from the academic session next following the date of issue of withdrawal order with a copy to State Government, Affiliating Body and all concerned.

Decision of WRC:

The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee decided to seek clarifications on the following points from the office of WRC NCTE:

- (i) After revisiting the case of Shree Swaminarayan B.Ed. College, Kalol, Dist. Gandhinagar, Gujarat WRC needs to get it clarified how the institution has violated NCTE Act, Rules and Regulation 2014 para-wise.
- (ii) WRC would like to get it clarified following points with reference to Gujarat Private Universities (Amendment) Act, 2022 published in the Gujarat Government Gazette, Education Department, Sachivalaya, Gandhinagar vide Notification dated 01.06.2022 that the parent bodies of TEI and University established by an Act passed by Gujarat Legislative Assembly are same or not. If Govt. of Gujarat has notified the University by virtue of powers delegated under law of the land and University has vested its powers for establishing constituent of the University or not.
- (iii) WRC also would like to get it clarified whether any affidavit is filed by the parent body or not.
- (iv) WRC, without any prejudice, also would like to get it substantiated that on what ground as per NCTE Act, Rules and Regulations 2014 the recognition of the institution is liable to withdraw by marking all such provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and Regulations 2014 through which it is justified.

On submission of clarification, matter to be placed in its ensuing WRC meeting.

The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

As per the order of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in WP (C) No. 4753/2025 dated 21.05.2025, the recognition of the B.El.Ed. course is restored.

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Decision of WRC:

The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time along with the reply to Final SCN after Letter of Intent and the Committee decided as under:

The institution be informed to submit original individual affidavit on Rs.10/- non-judicial stamp paper in respect of selected/appointed faculties together with original list of faculties in accordance with NCTE prescribed format within 15 days from the date of issue of the letter.

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Decision of WRC:

The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

- (i) Initially, the institution was running in rented premises and it has not been shifted to its own premises. After submission of revised land documents on lease, inspection of the institution at the new premises has not been conducted.
- (ii) The recognition granted to B.Ed. course with annual intake of 100 vide order dated 08.11.2009 has been withdrawn vide order dated 14.12.2020 and 14.08.2021 for non-fulfilment of NCTE Norms and Regulations related to own land and building and no reply to SCN received from the institution.
- (iii) On the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi vide Order dated 10.09.2021, the institution was permitted counselling on admitting students for the academic session 2021-22 vide letter dated 05.10.2021.
- (iv) On the decision of the Appeal Committee vide remand back Order dated 31.08.2023, restoration order dated 19.09.2023 was issued and Committee decided to conduct inspection u/s 13 of NCTE Act, 1993 to verify infrastructural and instructional facilities available in the institution and its related documents.

- (v) On consideration of VT Report u/s 13 dated 02.05.2024, Show Cause Notice u/s 17 dated 03.07.2024 was issued to the institution followed by Final Show Cause Notice dated 20.12.2024 to comply the deficiencies mentioned therein. The reply of Final SCN was considered by the Committee and found that the institution is still deficient in light of NCTE Norms and Regulations on the following grounds:
 - a) The institution has submitted the colour photocopy of CLU certificate dated 05.02.2021 signed by Patwari, Dist.- Pali, Rajasthan. Total built-up area mentioned as 2038 sqm. Total land area is not mentioned. As per VT remarks, the land is on private lease having total land area 1694.58 sq.mts. which less as per NCTE norms for 100 intake (two units) of B.Ed. course.
 - b) The institution has not submitted the latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate and indicating the Khasra No. and total area of the land.
 - c) The institution has submitted Building Plan signed/approved by PWD Engineer and Architect without showing date of approval. The same is not certified by Local Government. Khasra No. is not shown in the building plan.
 - d) Submitted Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Chief Officer, Pali, Rajasthan vide letter No. Fire/2024/4192 dated 02.05.2024 having general mistakes in the Hindi language. No Khasra/Plot No. and total area of the land has been mentioned in the NOC. The institution has not submitted copy of online fire certificate issued by LSG portal of Govt. of Rajasthan.
 - e) Submitted Building Completion Certificate with floor wise issued by Junior Engineer Municipal Corporation, Pali, Rajasthan signature without date. Total land area mentioned as 1694.58 sq. mtr. which is less against required 2500 sq.mts. and builtup area 2038.92 sq. mtr. date of construction in 2016. As per VT remarks dated 02.05.2024, one school is running on the same patch of land but in a separate building.
 - f) With regard to point regarding the college campus lacks accessibility features viz. lift, ramp, divvying toilets (there is only one toilet in the entire 4-storied building of the college, the institution mentions that these facilities are under construction.
 - g) With regard to point raised that most of the land documents were unclear and could not be viewed properly (during online presentation by the college team), the institution has not submitted land documents and attached copy of land possession certificate dated 05.02.2021 signed by Patwari, Pali mentioning that land bearing Chak No.2, total land area 6678 sq.mts. and allotted land area to the institution 3640 sq.mts. has been purchased from Nagar Vikash Nyas dated 09.02.1977 and related land document not attached.
 - h) With regard to point raised that latest approved faculty list by the affiliating body needs to be provided, the institution submitted photocopy of faculty list comprising 01+15 faculties without approval of affiliating body. The faculty at Sl.no.1 namely Sh. Satya Prakash, Perspectives in Education is not having PG in Social Science or PG (M.A) degree in education as per NCTE norms.

In view of the above, Committee decided that the recognition of B.Ed. course of the institution be withdrawn u/s 17 (1) of NCTE Act, 1993 w.e.f. end of the academic session next following the date of issue of withdrawal order.
