Decision of WRC:

The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time, proposal for shifting of premises and change of name of the institution and the Committee observed as under:

- (i) The institution has not submitted any compliance of Revised Recognition Order till date.
- (ii) The institution has not submitted any fee for Shifting of Premises of Rs.1,77,000/-
- (iii)The institution has not submitted Blue print of approved Building plan signed by the Competent Govt. Authority indicating the name of the course, name of the institution, Khasra No./Plot No., total land area, total built-up area with the measurements of the Multi-purpose Hall as well as other infrastructural facilities such as class rooms etc.
- (iv)The institution has not submitted Land Use Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority to use the land for educational purpose.
- (v) The institution has not submitted latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) issued by Competent Authority of State Government indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances.
- (vi)The institution has not submitted Certified copy of site plan with demarcated land area for running different courses.
- (vii) The institution has not submitted Building Safety Certificate in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.
- (viii) The institution has not submitted Fire Safety Certificate issued by Fire Safety Department, Government of Rajasthan verifiable on the official portal of the Fire Department, Government of Rajasthan at URL <u>https://lsgonline.rajasthan.gov.in/track_application.aspx</u>
- (ix)The institution has not submitted Certificate to the effect that the building is differently abled friendly from the Competent Government Authority.
- (x) The institution has not submitted latest Building Completion Certificate (BCC) in the prescribed format of NCTE (17 points) issued by the Competent Government Authority for all the courses being conducted in the premises.
- (xi) The institution has not submitted latest/current faculty list approved & signed each page by concerned affiliating body in original with the details of their teaching subject, date of birth, date of selection, date of joining, academic qualifications, teaching experience, NET/Ph.D. (NCTE's GOI dated 09.06.2017), salary structure and related documents duly attested by authorized management representative not submitted. And, notarized original affidavit of Rs. 100/- on non-judicial stamp paper by the management and Rs. 10/- non-judicial stamp paper by each selected/appointed faculty in the NCTE prescribed proforma.
- (xii) The institution has not submitted details of salary disbursed to the faculty along with six months Bank statement and account number of each faculty members.
- (xiii) The institution has not submitted copies of valid Fixed Deposit Receipts Nationalized/ Scheduled Bank towards Endowment & Reserve Fund in the joint operation mode with

Regional Director, WRC, NCTE & Management along with duly filled Bank Form "A" in original, verified/ signed by the Manager of the Bank as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.

The permission sought by the institution for change of premises and change of name are refused.

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Decision of WRC:

The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

- (i) On the last occasion, recognition for B.Ed. course was withdrawn vide order dated 18.01.2024 in continuation of previous withdrawal orders dated 05.07.2012, 04.04.2013, 21.03.2018 and 11.07.2023 issued from time to time for not complying the appointment of requisite teaching faculty as per NCTE Norms and Regulations by the institution. The Appeal Committee vide order no. NCTE-APP1011/1st Mtg./2025-Appeal Section-HQ dated 31.01.2025 remanded back the case to WRC with the following directions:
 "… After perusal of the Appeal Report, documents on record and oral arguments advanced during the online hearing, Appeal Committee of the Council concluded to remand back the case to WRC with a direction to verify the documents submitted in Appeal from the concerned affiliating University. The Appellant institution is directed to forward to the WRC the documents submitted in appeal within 15 days from the receipt of order of Appeal and after receipt of the same the WRC to take further necessary action as per the NCTE Regulations, 2014 guidelines and amendments issued from time to time as per direction given herein above."
- (ii) As per decision of 417th Meeting of WRC held on 07th-10th April 2025, the matter was referred vide letter dated 25.04.2025 followed by reminder letter dated 03.05.2025 to the Registrar and Vice Chancellor of University of Rajasthan (Affiliating body) with request to submit verification report related to appointed Principal and faculties pertaining to institution in accordance with NCTE Norms and Regulations as amended from time to time.
- The Committee in its 426th Meeting considered reply received on 29.05.2025 from (iii) University of Rajasthan vide letter No.Acad.II/2025/6139 dated 16.05.2025 and another letter vide No. Acad.II/2025/6185 dated 21.05.2025 signed by R.K. Jain, Additional Registrar, University of Rajasthan addressed to Regional Director, WRC, NCTE enclosing a photocopy of letter vide no. Acad.II/2020/37868 dated 16.12.2020 issued by R.K. Jain, Deputy Registrar, University of Rajasthan with copy endorsed vide letter no. Acad.II/2020/37869-74 dated 16.12.2020 signed by P.M. Gupta, Assistant Registrar (Academic-II), University of Rajasthan addressed to Secretary, Rajasthan Shikshak Prakshishan Sansthan Samiti, Shahpura Bagh, Amer Road, Jaipur related to list of teaching staff submitted by the institution to the affiliating university for approval. However, the University of Rajasthan has intimated vide aforesaid letter 16.05.2025 that the list of teaching staff was placed before the BOI meeting held on 26.11.2020 wherein the Committee has resolved to recommend that the list of teaching staff submitted by the college duly signed by the Principal and Secretary of the College be provisionally sent to NCTE, New Delhi with the conditions that the college will complete the approval of the

name of staff (teaching faculty) as mentioned in the list be sent to the NCTE, within three months failing which the NCTE will be informed to withdraw the list sent to it by the University.

- (iv) Accordingly, as per above decision of University, the provisional list so submitted by the said college, the same were signed by the University officials (the then Deputy Registrar and counter signed by the then Registrar after approval of the competent authority) and sent to NCTE for further necessary action. After that the said college were not submitted the list of qualified Teachers as well as Principal to the University for approval within stipulated time of 03 months, hence the Provisional list automatically cancelled which was sent to NCTE. Further, in the said letter dated 16.05.2025 of University of Rajasthan it is mentioned that due to the cancellation of building safety certificate of the college/institution by the Gram Panchayat Goner, the University has not given Provisional affiliation from session 2023-24 to till date.
- (v) In consideration of above observations made by University of Rajasthan (approving authority of Principal and teaching faculty) being affiliating body, it is revealed that the institution does not have any approved faculty as per requirements of NCTE Norms and Regulations as amended from time to time. The Provisionally recommended faculty list is not treated as valid now. Hence, the institution has failed to appoint the requisite teaching staff as per NCTE Norms and Standards, the ground on which recognition of B.Ed. course was withdrawn earlier.
- (vi) Moreover, the verified complaints against the institution for irregularities received from the Complaint Division, NCTE Hqrs. was considered by the Committee.

In view of the above, the Committee decided that decision taken by Committee in its 399th Meeting of WRC held on 09th – 10th January, 2024 for withdrawal of recognition, issued vide order dated 18.01.2024 still stands and shall remain unchanged and same be communicated to institution and all concerned.

Decision of WRC:

The Committee noted that the matter was placed in its 410^{th} Meeting of WRC held on $30^{\text{th}} - 31^{\text{st}}$ Decembre, 2024 for consideration of the complaint made against the institution and the Committee decided as under:

- (i) Copy of the complaint against institution Dated 01.10.2020 received on 03.06.2024 from Complaints Division, NCTE, HQrs. along with related documents based on the complaint be forwarded to the Collector/ District Magistrate (DM) to verify the allegations made on the complaint and to furnish a report thereon within 30 days from the date of issue of the letter.
- (ii) Copy of the complaint against institution Dated 01.10.2020 received on 03.06.2024 from Complaints Division NCTE, HQrs. along with related documents based on the complaint be forwarded to the concerned institution to submit their point-wise comments on the allegations made in the complaint. The institution is also required to submit reply in reference previous letter of WRC dated 07.03.2021 on the same matter within 21 days from

the date of the issue of the letter, failing which appropriate action u/S 17 of NCTE Act shall be taken against the institution.

- (iii) Copy of the complaint against institution Dated 01.10.2020 received on 03.06.2024 from Complaints Division NCTE, HQ along with related documents based on the complaint be forwarded to the concerned to the Affiliating Body to furnish comments on the allegation made on the complaint within 30 days from the date of the issue of the letter.
- (iv) The Committee noted that the letter dated 24.01.2025 was sent to The Collector/District Magistrate (DM), Collectorate office, Hanumangarh, P & T Colony, Hanumangarh-335512, Rajasthan and letter dated 24.01.2025 to the Registrar Maharaja Ganga Singh University, (Formerly University of Bikaner), Rajasthan for conducting the investigation in pursuance to the complaint in respect of the institution and furnishing the action taken within 30 days. However, no reply has been received from them till date.

The Committee in this meeting observed that the report from the DM and the Affiliating Body i.e. Maharaja Ganga Singh University (Formerly University of Bikaner), Rajasthan is essential and decided that the reminder letters be issued to the Collector/District Magistrate (DM), Collectorate office, Hanumangarh-335512, Rajasthan and the Registrar of Affiliating University, Maharaja Ganga Singh University (Formerly University of Bikaner), Rajasthan with an endorsement to Secretary, Higher Education, Government of Rajasthan and Chief Secretary, Government of Rajasthan with a request to expedite the same.

Decision of WRC:

The Committee noted that the institution has not submitted the compliance of the revised recognition order issued dated 10.05.2015. The First Show Cause Notice dated 26.03.2018 was issued to the institution. The reply dated 13.04.2018 was submitted by the institution to the First Show Cause Notice. Thereafter, a Show Cause Notice dated 07.11.2020 has been issued to the institution. However, the reply has not been submitted by the institution.

Further, a verified complaint vide letter dated 15.01.2020 has been forwarded by Complaint Division, NCTE, New Delhi, vide letter No. F.No. NCTE-C/PG011/13/2020-Complaint Section-HQ/129613 dated 22.04.2025 received in WRC on 09.05.2025 regarding misutilization of education qualification certificate submitted by Complainant during interview for the post of teaching faculty by the institution while not giving any appointment/selection letter to the complainant as alleged in complaint. The application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

- (i) The institution is required to submit certified copy of land documents issued by concerned Tehsildar /Revenue Officer. (If the same are in Regional Language, the institution is also required to submit notarized copy of English version of land documents)
- (ii) The institution is required to submit an attested notarized copy of land Use Certificate issued by the Competent Authority.
- (iii) The institution is required to submit a copy of Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Authority. The institution is required to submit an attested/notarized copy of Non - Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Authority.
- (iv) The institution is required to submit an attested/notarized copy of the approved Building Plan (if institution is running more than one Teacher Education programme, it shall be required to submit an exclusive earmarked building plan for each of the recognized Teacher Education programme).

Decision of WRC:

The online application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time along with reply of Show Cause Notice and the Committee observed as under:

- (i) The name of the institution "GLOBAL INSTITUTE OF B.ED COLLEGE" mentioned in the application and recognition order of B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. whereas "Global Institute Of Education & Research" mentioned in the university letter of affiliation with regard to Multi-disciplinary Programmes uploaded by the institution. Both the names are different. Therefore, as per NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time, the application of the institution does not fall in the category of Multi-disciplinary institution.
- (ii) The institution is required to upload Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government indicating the Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area and total built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes.
- (iii) The institution is conducting degree courses i.e. B.A. with 240 intake, B.Sc. with 140 intake combined intake of 380. The sufficiency of land and built-up area for 380 intake of multidisciplinary courses and 16 units for ITEP course cannot be ascertained. Since, as per the BCC uploaded by the institution, it has earmarked 2,000 sq.mtr. built-up area for teacher education programmes out of the 3,000 sq.mtr. total built-up area. The institution is required to clarify the same along with the supporting documents issued by the Competent Government

Authority.

- (iv) The institution is required to upload latest list/details of students admitted in the 4 year Integrated B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course year-wise (I,II,III & IV) duly approved and countersigned by the Registrar of the Affiliating University.

The institution is conducting degree courses i.e. B.A. with 180 intake, B.Sc. with 360 intake, B.Com. with 180 intake combined intake of 720. The sufficiency of land and built-up area for 720 intake of multidisciplinary courses and 4 units for proposed ITEP course, B.Ed. with 100 intake and D.El.Ed. course (Code-24213: mentioned on institution's website) cannot be ascertained.		
(iii)	The institution has uploaded an affidavit for Khasra Nos. 69, 221/1,221/6, 221/7, 222/222/7. The institution has uploaded land documents for Khasra No. 221/1, 121/6 and 121/ The institution has not uploaded latest Registered Land Document for Khasra no. 221/6, 221 & 69/3.		
(iv)	The institution has not uploaded Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of Sta Government indicating the Khasra/Plot/Survey No. and mentioning the total land area are total built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcate land and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinal programmes.		
(v)	The institution has not uploaded Not-for-profit Certificate issued by Competent Gov Authority.		
(vi)	The institution has uploaded Land Title Certificate in which Khasra No. 220/1 mentioned which does not mention in the other land documents uploaded by the institution.		
(vii)	The institution has uploaded Building Safety Certificate dated 03.04.2025 which has been issued by chief municipal officer of nagar palika parishad, deori in respect of plot no. 69 only The institution has not uploaded Building Safety Certificate mentioning a Khasra/Plot/Survey No. in adherence of safety guidelines as prescribed by National/State Disaster Management Authority issued by Competent Government Authority.		
(viii)	The institution has uploaded the latest list of teaching staff which is not latest and n countersigned by the Registrar of affiliating body as per qualification contained in the NCT Norms and Regulations as amended from time to time.		
(ix)	The institution has uploaded bank statement indicating the transaction of the salary remuneration to its teaching staff. However, it cannot be ascertained from the uploaded documents whether the institution is paying salary to its staff as per Central/State Governme pay scales in accordance with the norms and standards of NCTE.		
(x)	The website of institution has NOT been updated and maintained in compliance to provision under Clause $7(14)(i)$, $8(6)$, $8(14)$ and $10(3)$ of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

Decision of WRC:

The online application of the institution along with other related documents was carefully examined in the light of the NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time along with reply of Final Show Cause Notice and the Committee observed as under:

(i) The WRC has noted that the following two institutions have documents and addresses in common:

It is evident that both the institutions as well as their parent bodies (society/trust) are situated and functioning on the identical address.

The Committee further noted that the applicant has uploaded the same documents pertaining to land such as Mutation, CLU, NEC, Building Plan, BCC, etc. in both the applications in order to mislead the WRC. Further, Khasra Nos. mentioned in the online transition portal for B.R. CHAUDHARY COLLEGE are 33/243, 33/244 and Khasra No. mentioned in the online transition portal for Bansal College of Higher Education is 33/244. In this case, Khasra No. 33/244 is identical in both institutions.

- (ii) The institution is conducting degree courses i.e. B.A. with 80 intake, B.Sc. with 70 intake, thus combined intake of 150. The sufficiency of land and built-up area for 150 intake of multidisciplinary courses and 400 intake (8 units) for proposed ITEP course cannot be ascertained.
- (iii) The name of the institution as well as parent body (society/trust) mentioned in the Building Completion Certificate (BCC) does not match with the name of the institution as well as parent body (society/trust) mentioned in the online transition portal. Further, the same is not approved by the Competent Government Authority.
- (iv) The institution has uploaded Affiliation letter/order for B.A B.Ed. / B.Sc. B.Ed. course

which is issued to B.R. Choudhary T.T. College whereas the name of the applicant institution is Bansal College of Higher Education.

- (v) The institution has uploaded Exemption Certificate (12A) in the name of "B.R. Chaudhary T.T. Mahavidyalaya Prabandh Samiti 19 JRK KGM Garden Ke Samne, Goluwala Pilibanga Hanumangarh 335802, Rajasthan India" whereas name of the parent body (society/trust) mentioned in the online transition portal is Bansal Education Welfare Society.
- (vi) The institution has not uploaded Not-for-Profit Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority.
- (vii) The institution has uploaded list/details of students admitted in the 4 year Integrated B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. course which is not duly countersigned by Registrar of concerned affiliating University.
- (viii) As per the land documents uploaded by the institution, it has uploaded three gift deeds. The land is donated to B.R. Chaudhary T.T. Mahavidyalaya Prabandh Samiti whereas name of the parent body (society/trust) mentioned in the online transition portal is Bansal Education Welfare Society.
- (ix) The institution has uploaded Land title certificate in which name of the parent body (society/trust) is B.R. Chaudhary T.T. Mahavidyalaya Prabandh Samiti instead of Mutation Certificate/Jamabandi.
- (x) The institution has uploaded Change of Land Use Certificate (CLU) in the name of Karni Kripa Educational Society and B.R. Chaudhary Mahavidyalaya Prabandh Samiti whereas name of the parent body (society/trust) mentioned in the online transition portal is Bansal Education Welfare Society.
- (xi) The institution has uploaded Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) in the name of B.R. Chaudhary T.T. Mahavidyalaya Prabandh Samiti whereas name of the parent body (society/trust) mentioned in the online transition portal is Bansal Education Welfare Society. Further, the institution has not uploaded latest Non-Encumbrance Certificate (NEC) issued by Competent Authority of State Government and Khasra No. and name of the institution mentioned in the uploaded NEC does not match with the Khasra No. and name of the applicant institution mentioned in the online transition portal.
- (xii) The institution has not uploaded Building Plan approved by the Competent Authority of State Government mentioning the total land area and total built-up area earmarked for each course being run in the premises and the demarcated land and built-up area for the teacher education programmes including multi-disciplinary programmes. Further, the Khasra No. mentioned in the uploaded Building Plan 32/244 whereas the Khasra Nos. are 32/244, 33/244 mentioned in uploaded BCC.
- (xiii) The institution has not uploaded the latest list of teaching staff countersigned by the Registrar of affiliating body in the prescribed format of NCTE as per qualification contained in the NCTE Norms and Regulations as amended from time to time.
- (xiv) The institution has uploaded bank statement indicating the transaction of the salary / remuneration to its teaching staff. However, it cannot be ascertained from the uploaded documents whether the institution is paying salary to its staff as per Central/State Government pay scales in accordance with the norms and standards of NCTE.
- (xv) The website of institution has NOT been updated and maintained in compliance to provisions under Clause 7(14)(i), 8(6), 8(14) and 10(3) of NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

In view of the above, the application for transition to ITEP is rejected.
